A VISIT TO “KASHIBAI RAJ GHAT”

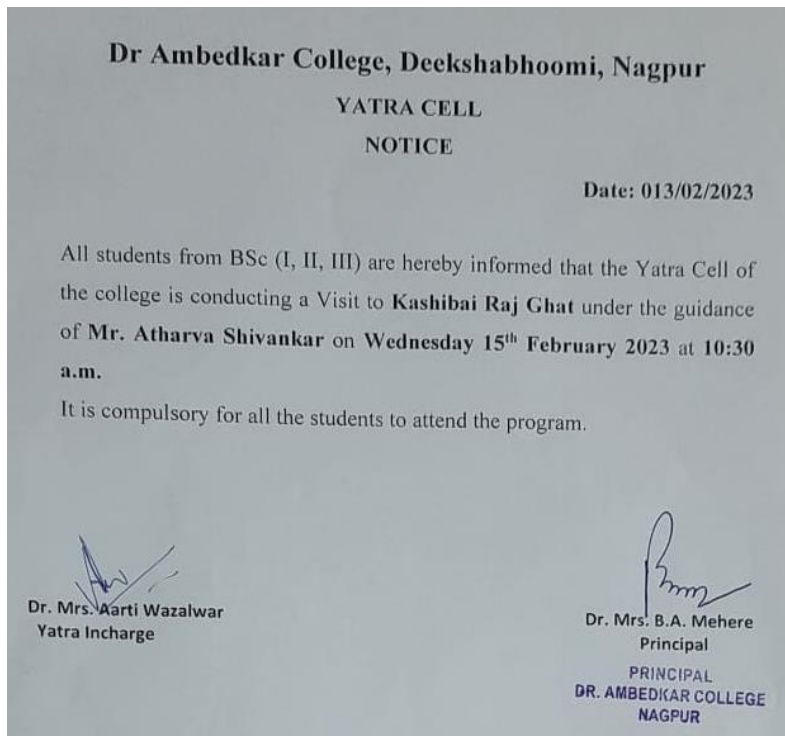

The Yatra Cell of Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi Nagpur organized a visit to **Kashibai Raj Ghat** on Wednesday 15th February 2023 at 10:30 am. A group of students accompanied by the faculty in charge Dr. A N Wazalwar and the instructor, Mr Atharva Shivankar was present at the spot. The first interaction with the students was the greeting by

the tour instructor who is a well-known history researcher of Nagpur city. The heritage walk was led by an instructor who first gave a brief explanation of the landscape and discussed its significance as a heritage site.

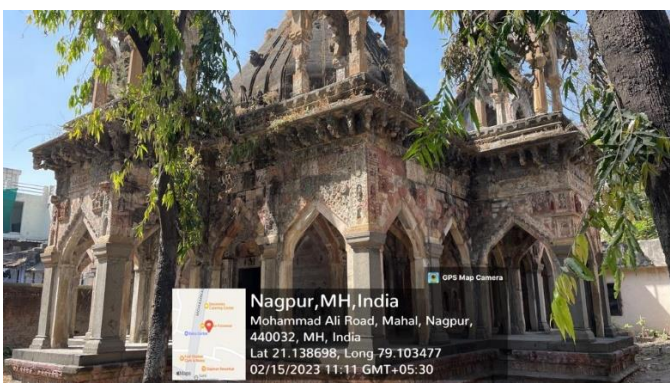
Atharva Shivankar began telling the story of Bhosale of Nagpur in a place where it all came to an end, a place in early times present at the bank of Naganadhi. Several memorials were built to commemorate the members of the Nagpur Bhosale. Till this date, all of the family members final rituals are formed there. Tulsivrundavan is placed on the samadhi of female members, while Pind of Lord Shiva is situated on the samadhi of male members. Huge Samadhi is a carved pillar with umbari and detailed designs surrounding it for all the heads of the family who hold the title of Senasaheb Suba. The tour began at Raghuji Bhosale I's samadhi, where Sir talked about the origins of Bhosale and how they came to Nagpur after the last Gond King and were given the title Senasaheb Suba by Chatrapati. The samadhi was built at Kashibai Raj Ghat in memory of Raghuji Bhosale I and his six queens who went Sati.

The Samadhi of Raghuji Bhosale II, Bakabai, Khandoji Bhosale, Parasoji Bhosale, and his wife Kashibai, Raghuji IV, were also discussed in detail by the speaker. He gave a brief explanation of each Bhosale Family heir's life and death, as well as their achievements. Every samadhi had different architectural influences that represented the time it was built and the importance that member held in Nagpur's history.

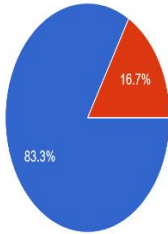
It has also been a memorable experience for all the attendees. After the session, he happily answered all the queries raised by the students.





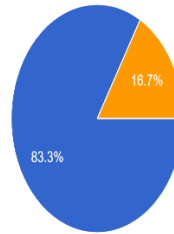

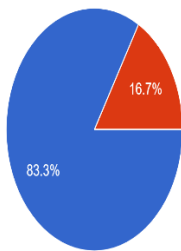

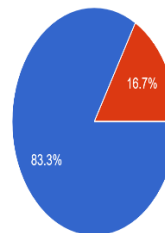
