





Dear Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi,

Thank you for submitting your 2021-2022 ACS Student Chapter Report! ACS is always very excited and proud to see the contributions you have made to your institutions, local communities, and to chemistry. Your report has been reviewed and feedback was provided by a panel of faculty advisors.

Your chapter received **Outstanding!** Feedback from the reviewers is provided below:

You did a good job! You worked on several professional activities, emphasized safety, participated in ACS activities (for example the National Chemistry week), and tried to reach underserved communities. You also worked with younger students and I encourage you to continue educating the new generations in working responsibly as chemists, by taking care of the environment. Games are great to make the learning process fun, but it would be more desirable to have some experts giving seminars and showing people how the new trends in chemistry are shaping the way we do science. They also will give examples of how industry is modifying processes for a more sustainable chemistry. That way students will have a better picture of what people are actually doing.

Working with farmers is a nice idea creating a link university/society, I praise you for this activity.

You focus a lot on college students interaction to help them to decide careers and that is great. Nevertheless, there is not that much interaction with other students who are not part of the university system. The interest on science starts earlier, and a good way to spark the interest of students on science is to work earlier with them. So, my suggestion for outreach activities is to work with elementary schools, especially those in small towns to do demonstrations. You also can work with high school students, perhaps coordinating with high school teachers and inviting them to visit campus and perform some demonstrations, showing them the facilities. That can also be a good way to recruit future majors.

You also mention you had and overcame some struggles, but there was not any specific example about it. It would be good to mention at least the most important challenge, that way we could give you suggestions.
