- Teachers' Day' on 5th September 2016 was celebrated by the students of Psychology. Teachers were greeted and offered handmade gifts by students.
- Educational Visit: An educational visit was conducted on 24th
 February 2016. It was an Interdisciplinary Visit to the Department of
 Zoology. Dr. R. S. Bagde, Head informed the students about several
 aspects of studies in zoology, its research areas and application. The
 most remarkable was his explanation on some of the simple

happenings that can be made into a commercialized approach. He informed students about making of fish ponds from where students can develop immediate industry.

Psycho-Social Counselling Cell

- The college has a unique cell where apart from academics and conventional studies, students are counselled on various aspects related to psychosocial behaviour and personality traits. The cell offers valuable guidance over career choice and potential inputs. Counselling is a much needed activity for everyone and taking into consideration the varied socio-economic background of students in higher studies, attending them to harness a uniform social approach becomes very necessary. Mrs. Seema Page, Dharampeth College, Nagpur was invited to speak on 'Importance and Need of Psycho-Social Counselling'. She talked at length on the needs of social behaviour and manners that need to be corrected and improved among all. A common man, parents or students are all subject to correction and this can be done only by a counsellor, she emphasized. At the end of the guest lecture an interactive session was conducted for the students where they put forth some of the gueries and they were answered well by the guest speaker as well as faculty members in
- A special lecture was organized by the cell for all students in the college. The topic was 'Time Management and Goal Setting'. Miss. Mangala Waghmare spoke on diverse aspects of time management and goal setting among students. She presented interesting information on how students can set simple and realizing goals where effective time management is highly needed. She suggested students not to set difficult goals in the beginning only but to stretch them over a period of time where everything can be realized with equal attention.
- On 2nd January 2016 an Aptitude Test was conducted for the students of Psychology. A questionnaire was developed and students were to answer them. Following evaluation of the answers, students were selected into different groups and accordingly counseled. Miss Mangala Waghmare and Miss Rohini Meshram counseled the students on various aspects of psycho-social behavior.

Department of Economics and History

- Department of Economics and Department of History jointly organized a programme on 6th October 2015 on 'Court' a movie nominated for Oscar Award. The lead role actor Mr. Veera Sathidar was invited to speak on the theme and relevance of the current practices in judiciary. The student were shown the movie and responses were invited in the form of discussion
- Student in B.A. I were taken on a tour to the Central Museum, Nagpur on 19th March 2016 by

Department of History, Economics & Political Science. The objective of the visit was to familiarize them with ancient and medieval culture of the world. They were given information on migration of human being and other species through times.

Department of Law

- On 29th September 2015, one day workshop on 'Alternative Dispute Resolution' was organized for 5th semester (3 years) and 9th semester (5 years) course to give students an insight on the topic. The workshop was conducted in two sessions. Dr. Aparna Panchbhai, In-Charge of Dr. Bababsaheb Ambedkar College of Law (City Branch) was invited as guest speaker for the first session. This was followed by introductory address by the Head, Dr. N. M. Khirale. Dr. Aparna Panchbhai enlightened the students on theoretical aspect of Alternative Dispute Resolution, wherein she explained the difference between traditional dispute-solving judicial mechanism and the alternative dispute solving mechanism. She also explained the concepts of Arbitration, Mediation & Conciliation elaborately.
- Adv. Deoul Pathak, practicing lawyer before the Hon'ble Bombay High Court, Nagpur Bench, Nagpur was invited as the guest speaker for the second session. Based on his vast experience in varied issues of law, he provided the students good insight on the practical aspects of Alternative Dispute Resolution. His deep knowledge combined with his oratory skills, proved to be very beneficial for the students. The workshop was organized and coordinated by Ms. Sayali S. Surjuse and Ms. Aditee A. Godbole under the guidance & supervision of the Dr. N. M. Khirale.
- Visit to Lok-adalat: Students were taken for a visit to Lokadalat on 23rd October 2015. It was organized by District Legal Services Authority, Nagpur. Students stayed at the Lokadalat and witnessed the cases that were referred to the Lokadalat by the Civil Court and the ones in which the parties at the first instance approached the Lokadalat themselves. Cases ranged from motor accident disputes to family disputes and payment of electricity and water charges as well as partition disputes, etc.
- workshop on Drafting and Pleading: One day workshop on drafting and pleading was organized to give practical training of drafting and pleading to the budding lawyers from the department of law on 3rd October 2015. Adv. Parag Ukey, Nagpur was invited as the guest speaker for the first session. He spoke on 'Drafting of Criminal Matter and Practical Exercise'. Adv. Rahul Rāthod spoke on 'Drafting of Civil and Service Matter'. Both lawyers trained the students on drafting & pleading at extensive level. This workshop enriched the students on practical aspect which is

very essential for a lawyer to practice in the corridors of the court. This was succeeded by an interactive session wherein the students' queries were dealt by speakers immaculately to their utmost satisfaction.

The workshop was ably organized and coordinated by Dr. (Mrs.) Sandhya Kalamdhad and Mrs. Shilpa Rathod. The program was compered by & vote of thanks was proposed by Mrs. Shilpa Rathod.

- Legal Aid Camp: Free Legal Aid camp was organized on the occasion of Dhammachakra Pravartan Din on 21st, 22nd and 23rd October 2015. Free Legal Aid Camp is an activity which inducts students every year to use their knowledge of law to provide free legal aid to thousands of people who come to Deekshabhoomi on Dusshera. The programme was inaugurated by Hon'ble Shri Justice Z. A. Haq who was the chief guest at the event. In his address he highlighted the importance of legal aid and also appreciated the harmonious working relationship between the faculty and the students of department of Law.
- Another workshop on 'Para Legal Volunteers Scheme' was organized on 14th October 2015 in association with District Legal Services Authority, Nagpur. One of the aims of the workshop was to impart basic knowledge to the students of 03 and 05 years course about the scheme. It was inaugurated at the hands of Shri. K. D. Jadhav, Civil Judge Sr. Dn. and Secretary of District Legal Services Authority, Nagpur. The workshop was planned in four technical sessions.
- In the first technical session Shri. K. D. Jadhav discussed the Para Legal Volunteers Scheme and Legal Aid in detail. In his speech, he appealed the students to be sensitive towards inequalities, injustice, violence and exploitation in the society. Later, Adv. Surekha Borkute, Member Juvenile Justice Board and D.L.S.A. discussed the issue of Juvenile Justice System. Further in the third technical session Advocate Rajendra Rathi, Mediator and Member of D.L.S.A. stressed the importance of Alternate Dispute Resolution. In the Fourth and last technical session Mr. Mushtak Pathan, District Child Protection Officer sensitized the students about the issues related to child trafficking and women trafficking and the law. Dr. Ms. Pratima Lokhande was the Co-Ordinator for the workshop.
- Free Legal Aid and Literacy Programme: The programme was organized at Athawa Mail, Wadi village under the guidance and supervision of Dr. N.M.Khirale, and Dr. Pratima Lokhande, with the motive to spread awareness amongst the villagers about their legal rights, government policies and facilities available to them. Students of VI semester 3 years course, X semester 5 years course, II semester 3 years course and LL.M. students attended the camp. Villagers were given information on various enactments such as Right

to Education Act, Motor Vehicles Act, Right to Information Act, Consumer Protection Act, Domestic Violence Act and similar other legislations. Special emphasis was on the rights of women, children and senior citizens under various enactments. Adv. Gajanan Agrawal and Adv. Shilpa Rathod attended villagers' querry and gave solutions to their grievances.

- Street Play 'Beti Bachao Beti Padhao' : The department organized a Street Play titled, 'Beti Bachao Beti Padhao' in Kachipura Slum area, Nagpur on 4th September 2015. This play aimed to highlight the Right to education of a girl child. In our Patriarchal social system, family decides to discontinue girl's education and get her married at a very early age. She is thus deprived of her right to education. With the help of innovative songs, actions and dialogues, the play emphasized the need to oppose the oppression of women and make them aware about their rights. The audience of Kachipura Slum area enjoyed and appreciated the performance and even pledged to save girl child and educate them. The skit was written by Miss. Varsha Tiwari and Mr. Akash Dhote of LL.B. I Sem. 3Y.C. The programme was conducted by Dr. N.M. Khirale, Dr. Pratima Lokhande and Mrs. Shilpa Rathod.
- Constitution Day Celebration 2015: Day was celebrated on 26th November 2015 in association with the District Legal Services Authority which also marked 125th birth anniversary of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar and adoption of the Constitution of India. The programme began by paying homage to Dr. B. R. Ambedkar's statue at Sanvidhan Chowk. Shri. K. D. Jadhav, Civil Judge Sr. Dn. and Secretary of District Legal Services Authority, Nagpur addressed the students and stated the significance of Constitution of India. Department of Chemistry
