Aptitude Test and Remedial Courses:

Within a month from the date of admission, the College conducts an Aptitude Test for the students. This is done primarily to identify the aptitude of the students in the chosen discipline. Based on this, innovative Remedial Courses are designed to help the weaker students to cope with the subject.

Evaluation Methods:

At DACN, students are evaluated through a series of evaluation methods ranging from simple class tests, unit tests, open book tests, random and surprise tests to class seminars, presentations on allotted topics, take home assignments and annual test examinations. Apart from these strictly academic parameters, a student is also evaluated on the touchstone of his/her participation in college and other activities and general overall behavior and mannerisms.

How can you join DACN...

Young friends, we welcome your decision to join DACN. But make sure you fulfill the following:

- 1. To join XI or XII std: You should have passed SSC or its equivalent in Summer 2022.
- 2. To join Graduate Study Programme (BA, BCom, BSc,BCA): You must have passed HSSC or equivalent examination in Summer 2022.
- 3. To join the LL.B (3years) course: You should have passed graduation in any stream from a recognized university and to join the LL.B (5years) course, you must have passed HSSC with a minimum of 45% marks (5% relaxation for students belonging to Scheduled Castes only). Admissions to both LL.B. (3YC) and B.A. LL.B. (5YC) are now strictly through MHCET (LAW).
- 4. To join any Post Graduate Degree Programmes, you must be a graduate in the respective subject from a recognized university.
- 5. For fees and other details please refer to the annexure attached to the application form.

Regulations:

- 1. The College campus is strictly a no smoking zone and consumption of alcohol and tobacco is strictly prohibited.
- 2. The College also strictly prohibits ragging and sexual harassment.
- 3. Use of mobile phones in college campus is strictly disallowed except for educational purposes.
- 4.75% attendance is mandatory for all students.
- 5. In the interest of security which is paramount, it is absolutely mandatory for all students to wear their Identity Cards without which entry in the campus is prohibited.
- 6. All tests and exams conducted in the college have to be compulsorily attempted.

- 7. All students must regularly read the Notice Board as they will not be separately intimated about everything important for them.
- 8. Students must take care while parking their vehicles in the allotted areas. Since parking has been entrusted to an independent contractor, students are expected to strictly follow the rules framed by the contractor. The college merely grants you the permission to park your vehicle and as such, any claim for loss or damage to the vehicle will NOT be entertained by the College.
- 9. The Principal reserves the right to grant, refuse or cancel admission at any point of time without assigning any reason whatsoever in the interest of the institution.

TEACHERS: DACN's Intellectual Capital

The teaching faculty at DACN is the institution's largest intellectual capital. Dedicated, committed and efficient teachers sharpen the acumen of their students, ignite their intellectual curiosity and equip them to take charge of their futures. But the role of teachers at DACN is not cabined within the frontiers of the classrooms alone. They lend a hand of support and confidence during phases of emotional turmoil, and are the anchors for students to lie at rest when storms hit them hard. Further, being themselves extensively involved in research, the faculties open new vistas of knowledge, thereby making teaching-learning an engaging, exploratory process for the students.

Tools Of Learning:

At DACN 'Edutainment' is our mantra where education and entertainment join hands to make the teaching-learning process very exciting. Teachers employ the traditional chalk and talk method and the lecture methods of teaching too. But this is augmented by the use of ICT and other audio-visual aids to help the students internalize what is taught. Extensive case studies are conducted to bring home the point to the students. Besides this, some topics are also learnt through dramas, street plays, etc. Keeping in line with technological advancements, the teaching faculty at DACN make extensive use of ICT in the teaching-learning process. The use of Google Classroom for sharing e-content as well as web resources as study material, sharing of audio-video lectures by some of the best faculties across the globe, has been a regular practice at DACN well before it became a compulsively necessity owing to the COVID-19 lockdown. The use of online platforms for conducting lectures, webinars etc on a routine basis makes teaching - learning at DACN a seamless and enriching exercise.

LIBRARY: A Rich Warehouse Of Knowledge

A rich library that stocks a wealth of books and study material is the pride of DACN. It houses a number of reference books, text books, journals, magazines, periodicals, novels and encyclopedias on a variety of subjects. The college has a Core library in every department too, from where quick references can be made. The College library also boasts of the INFLIBNET software which assists one to search, locate and know the status of any book. It is a repository of Research by Teachers. **Inter library loan service** has a tie up with 8 college libraries. A spacious **Reading Room** adjoins the library. Discipline and Silence cultivate the perfect reading culture' here, leaving you in an undisturbed privacy with the book at hand. There is also a separate section which provides study material for various Competitive Examinations.

DACN, being sensitive to the needs of the society, has also started the **Book Bank facility** which is a generous lending arrangement extended to the poor and needy students. The eligible students, under the scheme, are given Text Books for one academic year. **The library is also equipped with an internet facility for the students and faculty members with facilities to download.**

A Braille corner and JAWS in the library is a brilliant pointer to our inclusive and sensitive model of education.







LABORATORIES: Rich Experimentation Centers

Fully equipped, advanced and upgraded laboratories at DACN give students the pleasure to experiment on all that they have learnt in classrooms. There is an advanced **Computer Laboratory** apart from the Biochemistry, Physics, Electronics, Botany, Zoology, Chemistry and Statistics labs. A new **Biotechnology and Biochemistry Research Laboratory with state-of-the art equipments** is a special attraction of the college. A separate **IT Lab** and a new **BCA lab** are also functional. To facilitate research and short term courses, a Tissue Culture Laboratory is also set up in the Botany Department.





Animal Cell Culture Laboratory

Very few post graduate teaching departments in the RTM Nagpur University, Nagpur have a functional Animal Cell culture facility. Department of Biochemistry and Biotechnology, of Dr. Ambedkar College, has been proudly providing student consultancy services for more than 10 years in the field of Animal Biotechnology. Postgraduate and Doctoral Students of Pharmacy, Dentistry, and allied medical fields are routinely availing the services for animal cell culture. We maintain various cancer cell lines for work related to tumour biology, drug development and screening, anti-metastatic potential analysis, toxicity and signalling profile etc. Cells are also maintained for modelling and in vitro screen for obesity, diabetes, Alzheimer's disease, and immunomodulation studies.








Spoken English: For a Refined Personality


RESEARCH AND INNOVATION

Institutional Innovation Council and Technology Incubation Centre

Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur has time and again shown an unflinching determination towards implementation of new and game changing methods for providing an unparalleled platform to its students. Once again, the college has demonstrated its commitment towards student success through delivery of quality outcome in the field of nurturing student entrepreneurial skills. Despite being a nontechnical higher educational institute Dr. Ambedkar College, established an Institutional Innovation Council (IIC) and provided its students a forum to discuss and test new innovative business ideas with expert faculty members. The IIC at the college is coupled with a technology incubation centre wherein new technological innovations imagined by the students can be tested for obtaining a Proof of Concept (PoC). PoC can then be taken up further for prototyping and if found relevant even for intellectual property generation. The IIC of Dr. Ambedkar College brings in together the expertise of all its in-house faculty members and thus helps the budding student entrepreneurs to develop a thriving business solution. Within a short span of its establishment at the college the IIC got its affiliation to Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India (Gol). One of the start-ups incubated at the college IIC and technological Incubation centre raised a seed round of Rs. 1.45 Cr and went on to be recognised as the Best Early-Stage Cancer Diagnostic Start up- South Asia 2021 by Global Health and Pharma's Biotechnology Awards 2022. Curo Biosciences Pvt. Ltd. Nagpur under the brand name of "ErlySign" has already started creating a buzz in the Health Tech industry and is backed up by Southeast Asia's giant in cancer care network called Health Care Global (HCG) Ltd. Another student entrepreneur, Mr. Priyal Dhunde working in agricultural pest management domain went on to receive the prestigious Global Student Entrepreneur Award of Rs. 1 Lakh at the regional level. With such success stories to its credit IIC at Dr. Ambedkar College, Nagpur also became the first ever non-technical HEI to receive the 2-Star Status from MoE, Gol and got listed in the prestigious Atal ranking of Institutions for Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) 2021 as one of the best Performing Institutions in India under the non-technical academia band. Dr. Ambedkar College, Nagpur wants to setup itself as a role model for all the non-technical HEIs in the region to participate in such national initiatives for the benefit of their students. With such initiative in the college, the students are encouraged to live up to their dreams and conceive innovative ideas which can be nurtured here to create a fertile ground for self-employment opportunities even for the students studying in non-technical/non-professional courses.


'Unnati': Signifying Progress

LL.M. Course (Choice Based Credit System)

There are three specialization groups, out of which one group has to be opted by the students at the time of admission.

They are:

- 1) Group B Constitutional Law and Administrative Law
- 2) Group D Business Law
- 3) Group G- Criminal Law

(In each of the groups, 25 students will be admitted on merit) Each student taking admission to the LLM course has to study eight compulsory courses irrespective of the specialization which he/she has chosen. Out of the eight compulsory courses, two compulsory courses are prescribed for first semester, two compulsory courses are prescribed for second semester, two compulsory courses are prescribed for third semester and two compulsory courses are prescribed for fourth semester. Further in each group of specialization, there are six optional core courses representing specializations offered and which are required to be studied for that specializations. Apart from the compulsory and the optional core course papers, the students have to select and study one elective core course paper in third and fourth semester each to be selected from the list of the electives provided for each semester or in the alternative the student can choose any one foundational course from the list of 41 foundational courses excluding the foundational course in law.


