To develop the institution into a premier learning centre to produce diligent and ethically responsible professionals contributing significantly to a comprehensive socio-economic development of the society.

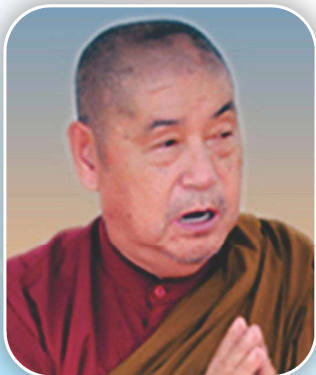

## HOW TO APPLY

### Young Friends,

We appreciate your decision to choose DACN. Please ensure you meet the following criteria:

- ❖ To join XI and XII standards, you should have passed the SSC or its equivalent examination. (Admissions will be strictly through a centralised admission process. ([www.mahafyjadmissions.in](http://www.mahafyjadmissions.in)))
- ❖ To join Graduate Study Programmes, you must have passed the HSSC or equivalent examination.
- ❖ To join BCA, you must have passed the Common Entrance Test (BCA-CET) organised by CET cell specially for BCA. Also, Mathematics is compulsory in 12th standard.
- ❖ To join LLB (5 Years Course), you must have passed HSSC or equivalent examination & for LLB (3 Years Course) you must be a graduate from any stream with a minimum of 45% Marks (5% relaxation to students belonging to Scheduled Caste). Admissions to both LLB 3 years and LLB 5 Years are through MH-CET (Law).

### CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE STUDENTS

A student must, upon admission, obtain an Identity Card having his/her photograph attested. The student is required to wear the Identity Card in person whenever he/she is on campus and present it for inspection on demand. In case the identity card is lost, the matter should be immediately reported to the Principal, and an application should be made for a duplicate Identity card as per procedure.

- ❖ Be prepared for a rigorous schedule of academic inputs, projects, assignments, presentations, examination and other activities planned throughout the year.
- ❖ Follow a disciplined culture with supportive behavior.
- ❖ Follow the academic timetable.
- ❖ Produce valid reasons for absence from the institute.
- ❖ Abide by the university rules and regulations as noted from time to time.
- ❖ Attend formal functions, seminars, and lectures by the institution on a mandatory basis.
- ❖ Cultivate the habit of reading the information exhibited on notice boards that are fixed in different places in the main block.
- ❖ Organise all activities under the guidance and supervision of the Teacher-in-Charge and with prior written permission.
- ❖ Maintain a minimum attendance of 75% per subject per semester. Misbehaviour, habitual late coming, disobedience, absenteeism, consumption of drugs, Smoking, chewing of pan masala, alcohol in the premises, malpractices, cheating in the exam, and such indecent activities unbecoming of a student shall attract strict disciplinary action.
- ❖ Do not engage in ragging practices. Ragging is strictly prohibited within or outside the campus. (Affected students must immediately report all instances of ragging to the Head of the institution in writing. Anyone found guilty of ragging is liable to be punished as per the existing law and UGC Guidelines.)
- ❖ College has a zero tolerance policy for sexual harassment. Complaints can be lodged with the Internal Complaints Committee of the College.
- ❖ Maintain silence in the reading room and library.

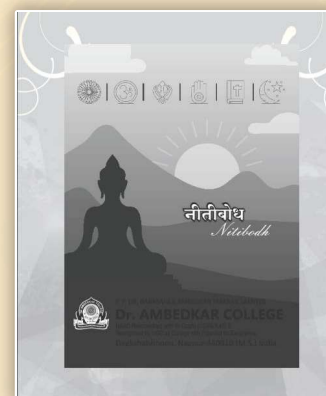
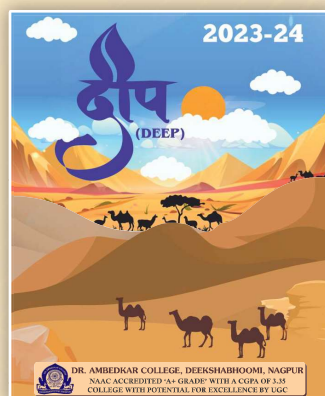
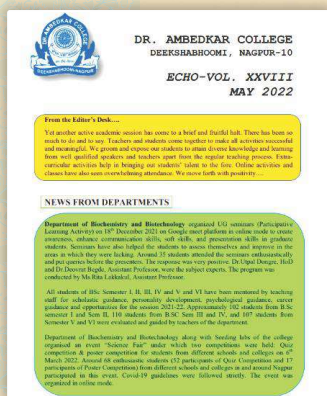
## INCUBATION CENTRE AT DR.AMBEDKAR COLLEGE, DEEKSHABHOOMI, NAGPUR

### Another feather in the cap through the Incubation Centre

**Shubhendra Singh Thakur**, an alumnus of Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur, leveraged his academic foundation in biology to pioneer groundbreaking innovations in healthcare. Graduating from the institute, he honed his scientific curiosity and entrepreneurial drive, which later propelled him to co-found ErlySign (CURO Biosciences Pvt. Ltd.), a biotech startup revolutionizing early cancer detection. His alma mater played a pivotal role in his journey by providing 'incubation support' to CURO Biosciences during its nascent stages, fostering the transition of his 2018 college lab project—a prototype for non-invasive cancer diagnostics—into a scalable venture. Under Thakur's leadership, ErlySign developed India's first saliva-based oral cancer test (98.04% sensitivity, 100% specificity), securing ₹16 crore (2024) in funding and partnerships with institutions like HCG. The college's ecosystem of mentorship and resources helped shape his mission to democratise affordable diagnostics, with plans to expand into CRISPR-based multi-cancer detection. From biology student to biotech CEO, Thakur's journey underscores the transformative role of academic institutions like Dr. Ambedkar College in nurturing innovators who bridge healthcare gaps globally.
