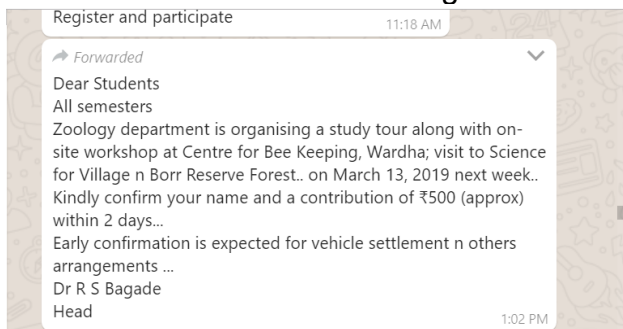

MARCH 14, 2019 **ON-SITE WORKSHOP- CENTER VISIT- FIELD STUDY**

As we arrived closer to Wardha the buses split to two different destinations viz., Center of Science for Village (CSV) run and managed by Dr Pandaya and the Center for Bee Management (CBeeD) managed by Dr Gopal Paliwal. One batch of students at CBeeD attend the on-site workshop of "Bee Keeping and Honey Extraction and Packaging" comprising of exclusive lecture with a PowerPoint presentation ; Lab testing tools for purity check and the honey extraction and packaging in their small scale unit. Students had hand on experience of honey testing and packaging. Bee keeping boxes and the honey extraction from the hive/combs and the related protection gear information was provided by Dr Paliwal with their assistants. Dr Mrs Paliwal enlightened with testing procedures.
