
This workshop will motivate the students to get a genuine and practical interest in herbarium management required for maintaining local biodiversity record.

**“WORKSHOP ON HERBARIUM TECHNIQUES”.**

Workshop on Herbarium Techniques” was conducted by Botanical Society, Dept. of Botany, Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur. **Dr. N. R. Ugemuge**, Maharashtra State Biodiversity Board, Nagpur was the recourse person for the said workshop on 20/02/2019.

Prof. S.R. Somkuwar, Head, Dept. of Botany, Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur has briefed about the aims and objectives of the workshop. The objective of the workshop was to gain hands on skills and experience that will enable students to develop and make use of their own herbaria/museum for future scientific references.

Dr. N.R. Ugemuge explained and gave hands on training about the herbarium preparation techniques, requirements by giving some relevant examples. He has awaked the students about the conservation of RET plants and judicious use of RET plant part/s for herbarium preparation.

He further stressed that herbarium preparation and maintenance is not a onetime process but a continuous process and an institution should always be encouraged to maintain and improve herbarium standard for future plant biodiversity research. He expressed his gratitude on being invited to the workshop. Keeping in view the present scenario he emphasized the importance of carrying out of various activities in the context of skill based workshop in the subject of plant sciences which are highly required in the recent Skill India Mission.
