Editorial Statement for the Proceeding:

The ultimate objectives of the conference were to share experiences, inspire students-researchers-farmers to build networks and to reduce R&D gap. The objective of the National Conference was to ensure a dynamic exchange of scientific and technological ideas which established a symbiotic relationship among researchers, industrialists, scientists and academicians. The conference served as a platform for sharing research experiences at different levels, from high-level socio-economical debates to grassroots agri-biosciences interventions. The main outcome of the conference was a “Joint Call for Action for Plant Health-2020”, to work together for the achievement of inclusive agriculture, eco-sustainable development, food and nutritional security. The conference provided an opportunity for key stakeholders to raise and discuss a wide range of issues of agriculture, rural development, innovations in Biological Sciences, food and nutritional security policies etc.
