

Dr. S. R. Somkuwar, Head Dept. of Botany Department Dr. Ambedkar College Deekshabhoomi Nagpur (DACDN) in his address emphasized that many forests areas across the Nagpur region have undergone significant loss of forest areas with deforestation and degradation with negative impacts on biological diversity and peoples' livelihoods.
