Welcome address given by Chairperson of the Event, **Dr. (Mrs.) B.A. Mehere**, Principal, Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur. **Dr. Subhash R. Somkuwar**, Convenor & HoD Dept. of Botany, Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur conveyed introductory remarks of the mega seminar. **Mr. Ishukumar Asati**, Co-Convenor & Co-founder, Spartan IAS



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Academy, briefed about the various courses for competitive exams run by Spartan IAS Academy.

In Session 1, first guest speaker **Mr. Prashant Hande**, *Deputy Superintendent of Land Records, Chandrapur District* enlightened the participants about the various MPSC competitive exams, its formats, study techniques etc. He also emphasized on that the students must acquire knowledge rather than mere information. In Session 3, third guest speaker **Mr. Sunny Kumar**, *Preventive Officer, Customs Dept., Govt. of India* guided about how to crack UPSC/SSC examination. He gave some tricks for various job skills, technical skills, soft skills and life skills which makes students to be able to go through the various competitive exams especially banking, insurance and finance.
