The Department of Commerce organized a 9 Days Induction Programme- **DEEKSHARAMBH**. In this program a visit was organized to Deeksha Bhoomi. Mr. Rahul Moon, Head of the Department of Ambedkar thoughts, guided the students about the history, architecture and significance of Deekshabhoomi. He explained how Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar had declared in 1935 that although he was born as a Hindu but he would not die as one, as conversion was only the solution to abandon the caste system. After this declaration, he extensively studied the doctrines of all the major religions to choose Buddhism for himself and downtrodden. On 14 October 1956, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar and his wife took the oath from the Burmese monk Mahasthavir Chandramani from Kushinagar. Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar then also gave the oath of Three Jewels, Five Precepts, and 22 Vows to his thousands of followers during the movement. In this way, Nagpur became the birthplace of the Neo Buddhist movement. He also described in detail how the geographical land of Deekshabhoomi spreads over 22 acres, covered with lush green beautification and the central part is dedicated to the giant *stupa* and also the history of the Bodhi tree was also given in detail. Shiv Dan Mal, a famous architect in Nagpur was handed over the responsibility to design a befitting structure of the stupa. The visit was filled with knowledge and enthusiasm of students who were in awe of the auspicious Deekshabhoomi. Mr. Rahul Moon gave a beautiful presentation on all aspects of Deekshabhoomi and enlightened the students about its significance. Around 50 students attended the program. At the end, Dr. Varsha Panbude proposed a vote of thanks.

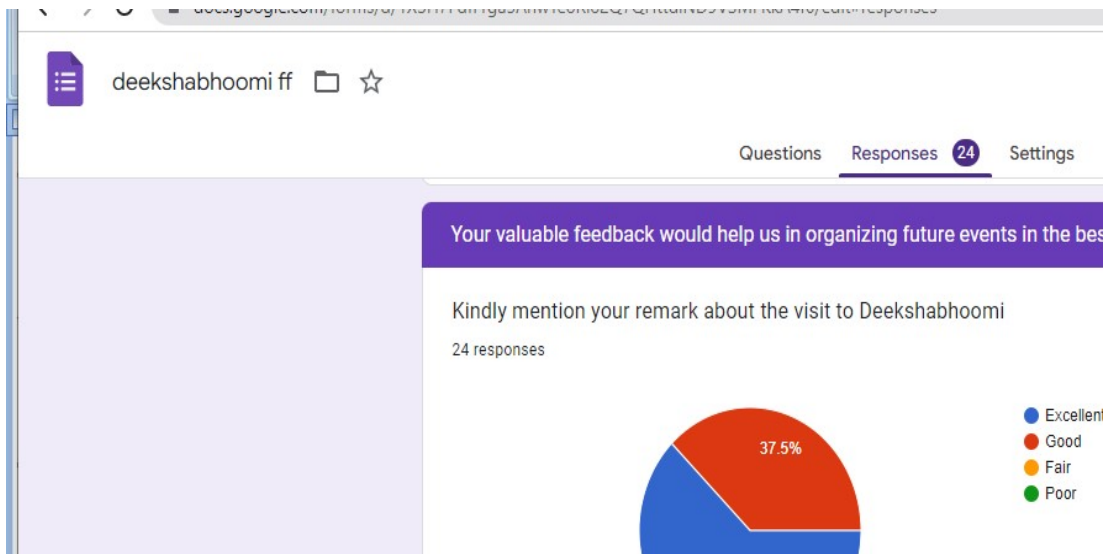

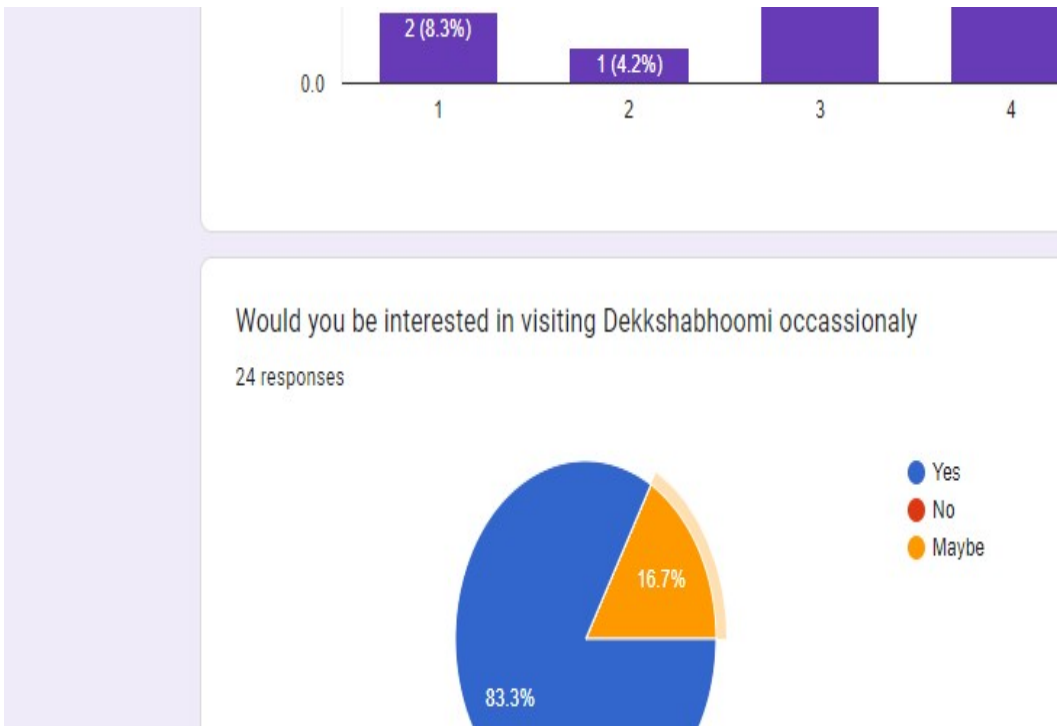
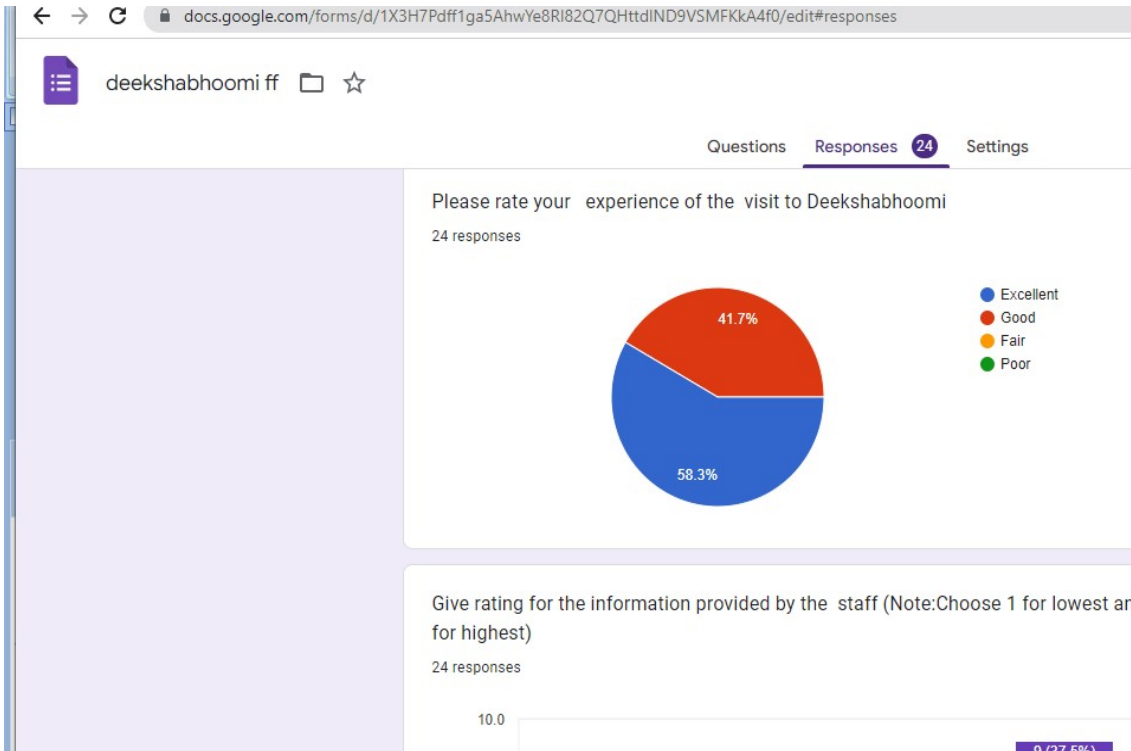
