The major objective for organizing the competition was to create larger awareness among the students who are the primary users of online transaction facilities these days. Though online transactions are preferred for they are hassle-free and save a lot of human labour and timing for simple operations such as transfer of amount and deposits, they involve a risk.

The risk factor is mostly overlooked due to paucity of time and precautions are not taken as they should have been. This is the juncture where we forget the security measures and fall prey to the frauds. We receive messages and alerts on precautions and security measures from the banking institutions but most of us don't pay heed to and consider them all as casual alerts.

The hackers generally take advantage of the lacunae on the side of banking app users and steal the data to create frauds. There are several cases where many of us have been cheated within these transactions. A few of those who are cheated get relief as they report the cases to Cyber Security Cell immediately but not everyone gets that.

Taking into consideration all such factors, students prepared charts on different aspects of the topic and presented them in a convincing manner. Dr. Ms. Rashmi Gupta and Dr. Ms. Chetana Soni from Dr. Ambedkar Institute of management Studies and Research, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur-10 were invited to adjudge the posters. Participating students presented their posters to the judges and on the basis of content in the poster, graphics, vocabulary used in presentation, etc. order of merit was decided.
