While warning the students, Dr. Gautam Kamble said, do not take any shortcut while acquiring knowledge. Understand the difference between information and knowledge. In today's age of technology, with the advent of information tools, there is no longer any need for them, but there is a real need for knowledge. In presidential address, the principal of the college, Dr. Mehere, spoke about how much effort Babasaheb Ambedkar had to put in to acquire knowledge.
