


World Population Day is observed every year on 11th July, it was declared by United Nations Development Programme in 1989 when the population of world crossed 5 Billion. World Population Day, which seeks to focus attention on the urgency and importance of population issues. To celebrate World Population Day, an online webinar had been organized by Department of Commerce, Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur on 11th July, 2021. The theme of webinar was “World Population: Prospects & Challenges in Context of India”. On this day guest lecture was delivered by Dr. Murali Dhar, Professor, International Institute of Population Sciences, Mumbai and Dr. Vinayak Deshpande, Former Vice-Chancellor, Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University. Principal, Dr. B.A. Mehere gave a warm welcome to the guest speakers. Dr. Mrs.Varsha Panbude, Head of the Department gave introductory remark on the theme. The webinar was co-ordinated and by Mrs. Shefali S. Chouksey and Mr. Sankalp Hadke.



Dr. Murali Dhar spoke about “Historical Perspectives and Future Prospects of Population Policies in India” with the help of a power point presentation in which he covered demographic features in last century, evolution of policies in India, present status of population and he concluded his presentation by narrating future prospects of population policies, he also talked about demographic dividend and gave recommendations in which he told how to utilize this dividend in order to make India sustainable.

Dr. Vinanyak Deshpande spoke about “Population – are we leading towards population explosion?” he explained the term population explosion and how it is a threat to our country, he also stated that population is a social process and not mathematical process, in his presentation he provided data which portray social indicators like health, standard of living, education, etc has been changing and more people are becoming literate and using contraception. He concluded his presentation by explaining how population can be controlled by development of social indicators and development is the best contraceptive.

At last, the vote of thanks was delivered by Mr. Sankalp Hadke, Faculty, Department of Commerce. He thanked the guest speaker for their precious time and guidance to students. Around 42 students participated in this webinar. The webinar has established a new benchmark in understanding the topic in holistic way. 




