Day 6 : EXPRESS-TION –Creative art and culture – each student express his/her talent in two minutes

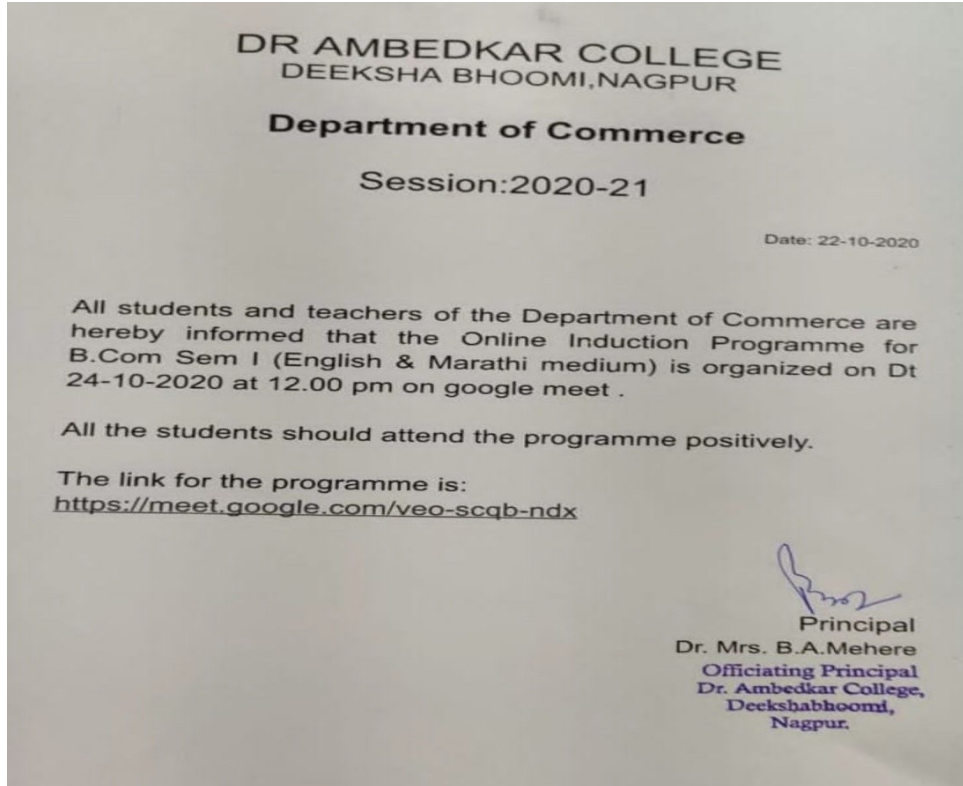
Day 7 : Guest Lecture and Group Discussion on Universal Human Values

## DAY 1 ACTIVITY: ONLINE INDUCTION PROGRAM

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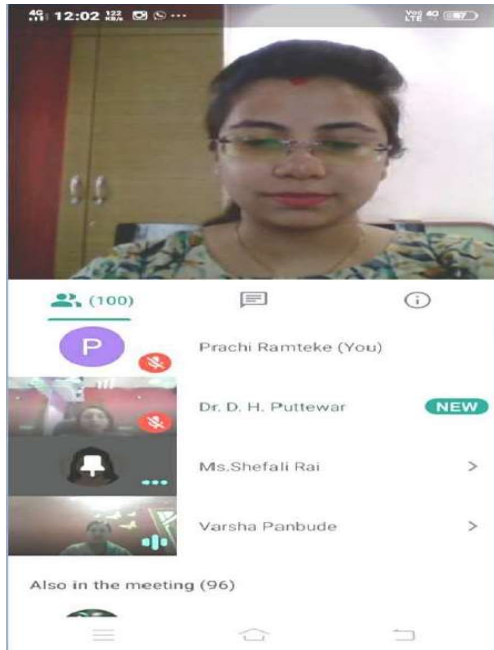

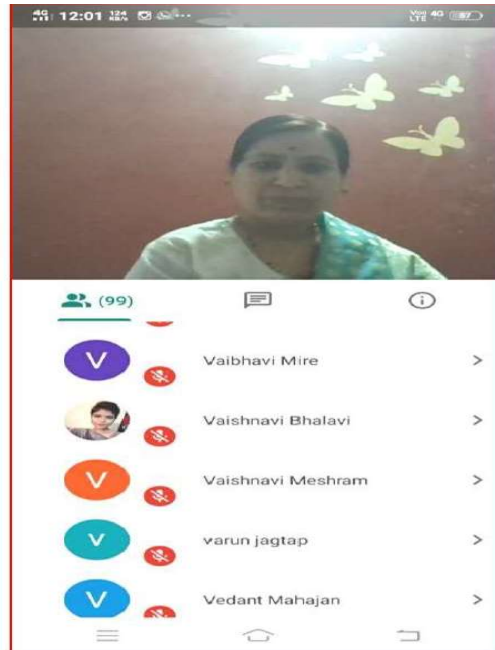
Later Dr. Ms. D. H. Puttewar has explained the history, heritage, facilities provided and other aspects of the college through the PowerPoint presentation.

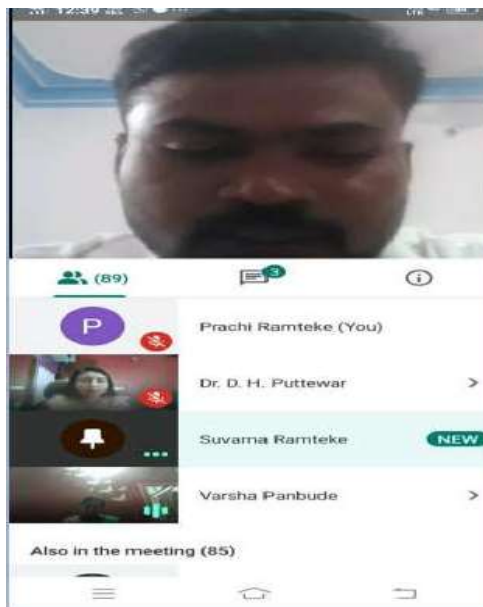

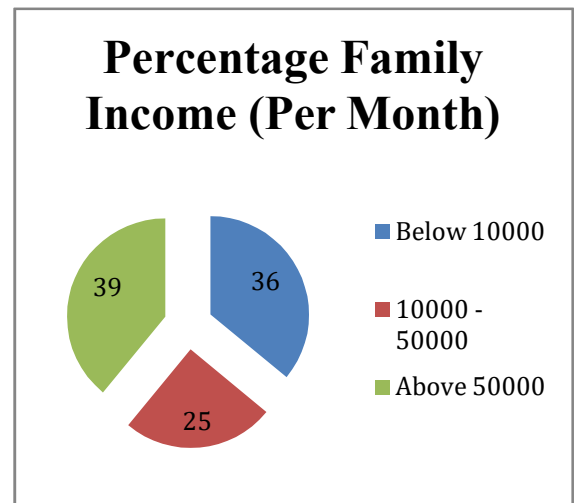

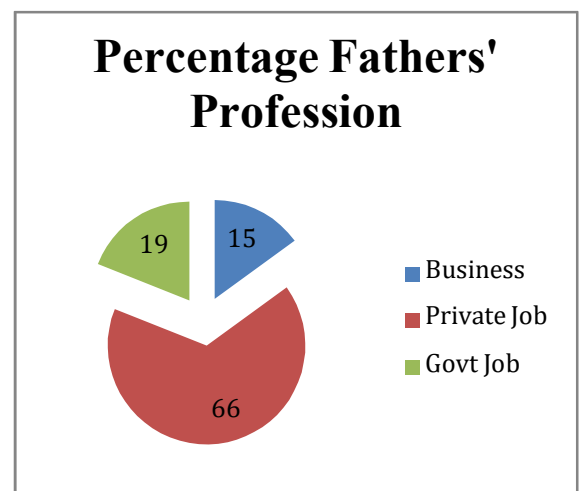
## DAY2 ACTIVITY: INTRODUCTORY SESSION

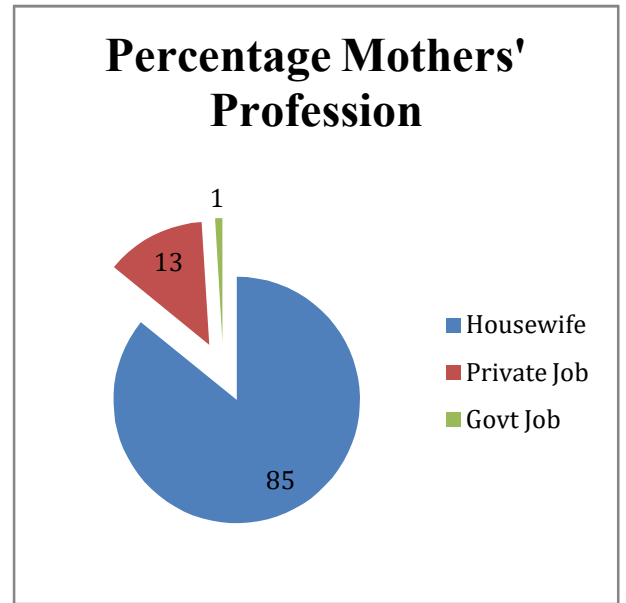

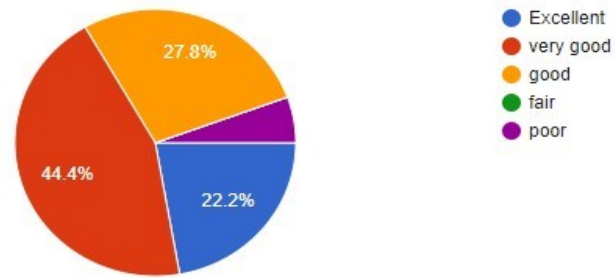

Sopan Joshi’s “Jal Thal Mal” is a book in Hindi about the invisible connections that sustain us in our life on the planet. It shows how sanitation is not just a matter of public health but is linked to the water pollution and to the fertility of our soils. It tells us how we continuously ignore the triangular link of our excreta with our water and land. The author tries to convey the message that how the transition in the sanitization system has polluted the environment i.e. Water and Land and how the contamination of water and land has affected the human beings and animals. 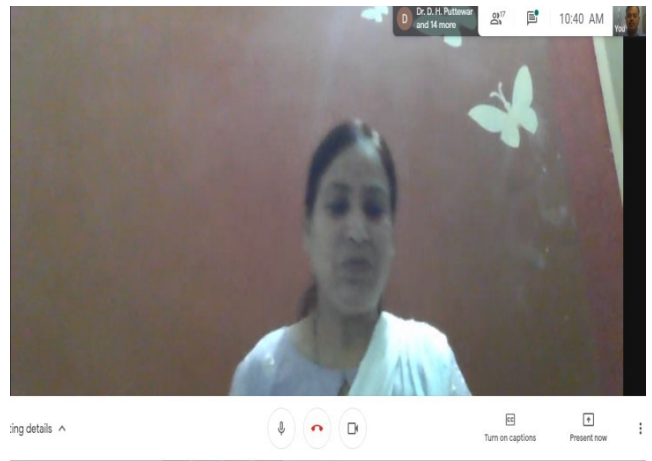
work is very important but it is considered as non-dignified. Author also suggested measures to protect the environment for avoiding further pollution.

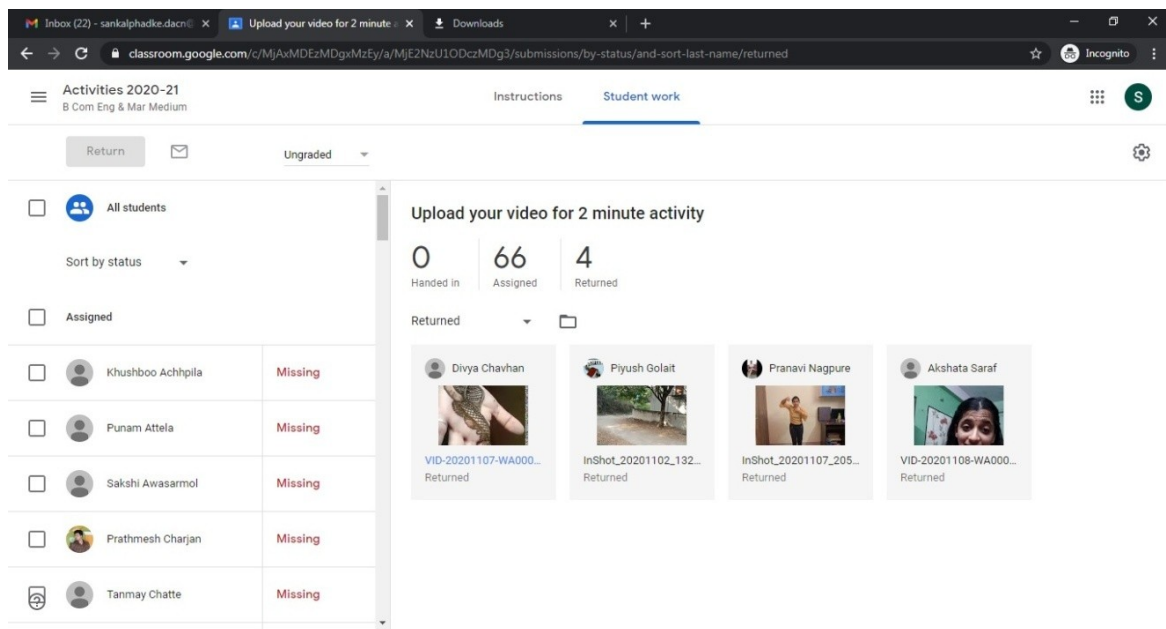
## DAY 6 : EXPRESS-TION – CREATIVE ART AND CULTURE

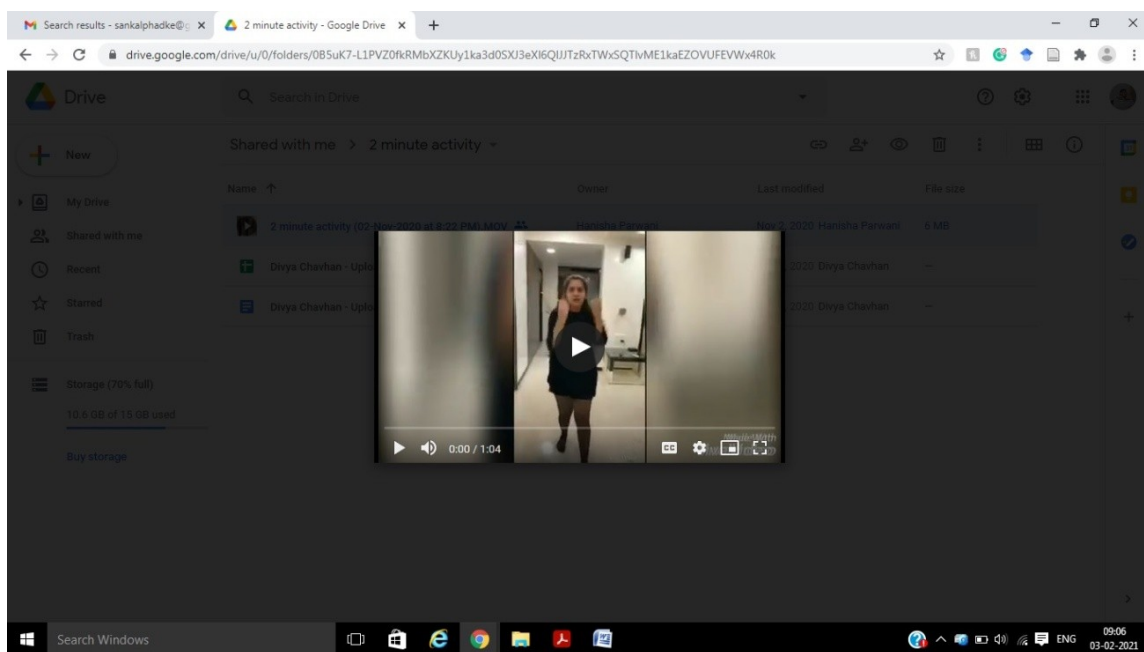

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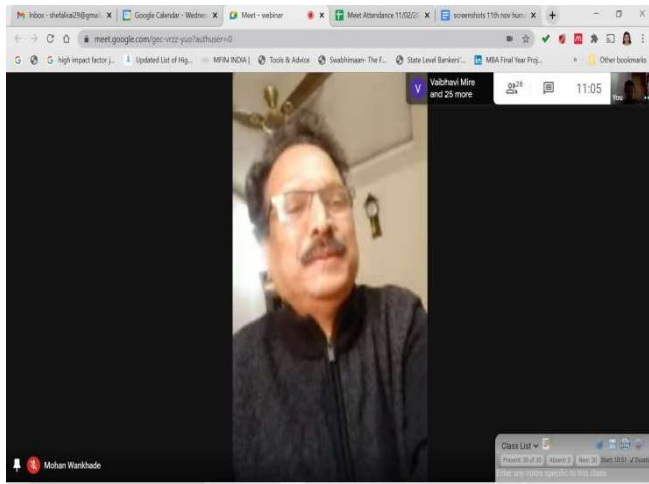

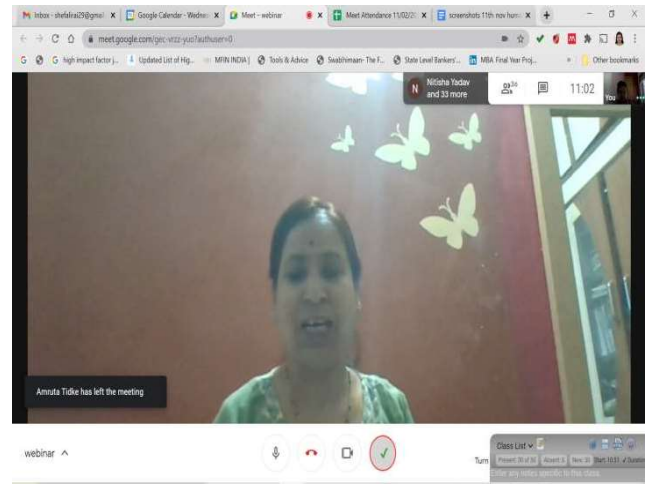
that values and customs need to be modified according to new age requirements. A clear and moral mind builds great society. Hence a proper environment has to be created.

Mrs. Shefali S. Chouksey proposed a vote of thanks. The webinar proved to be a great success.



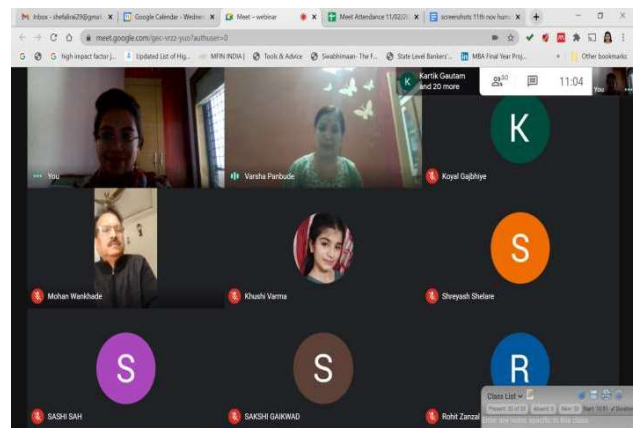
