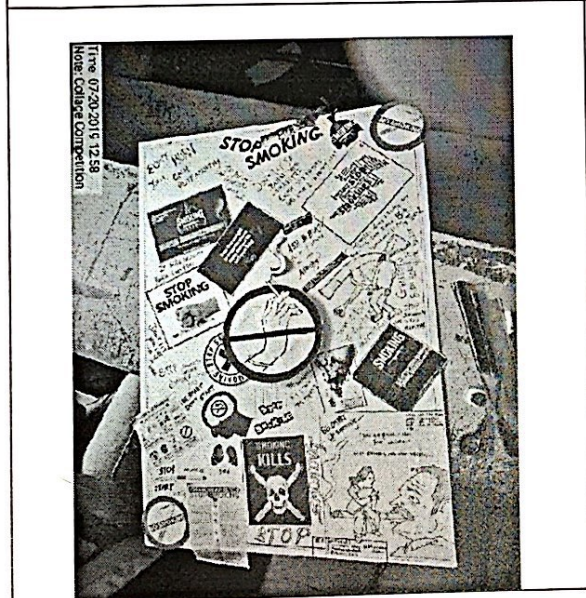

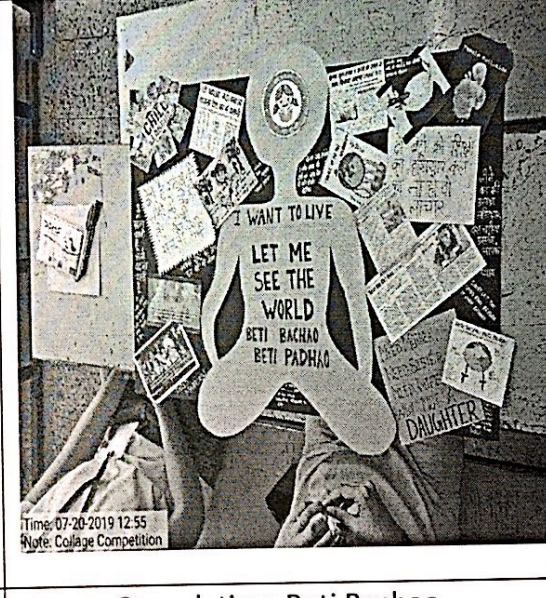
1ST prize: Portrait Art

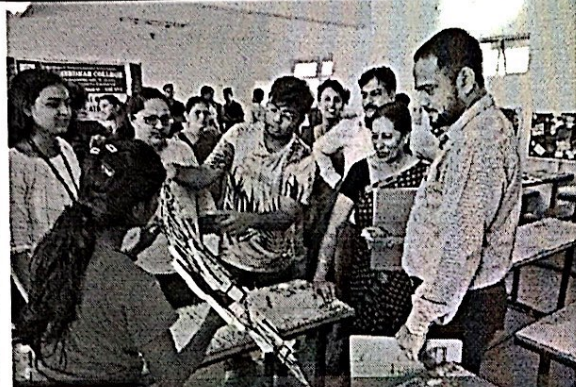

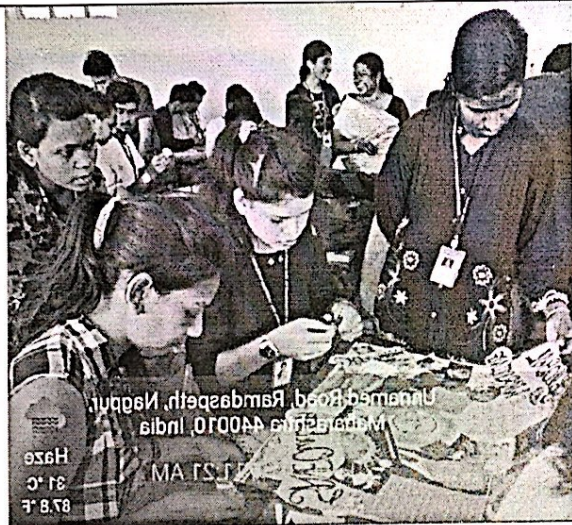
