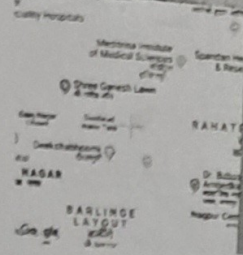
Topic "Unemployment and Recession"

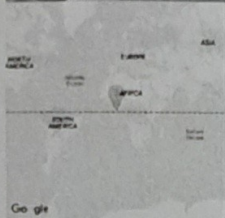

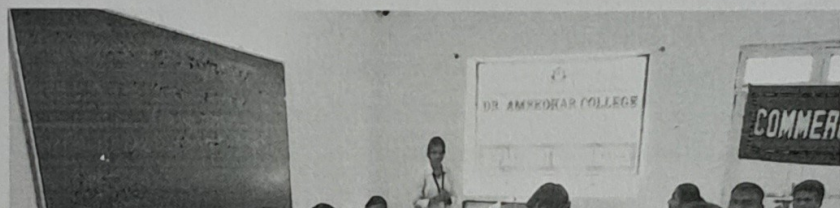
