Arundhati Patil- legal language



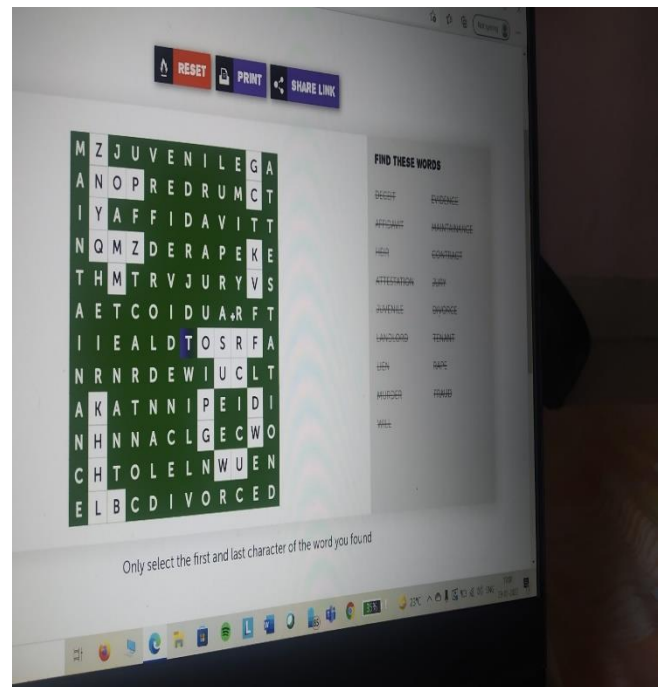
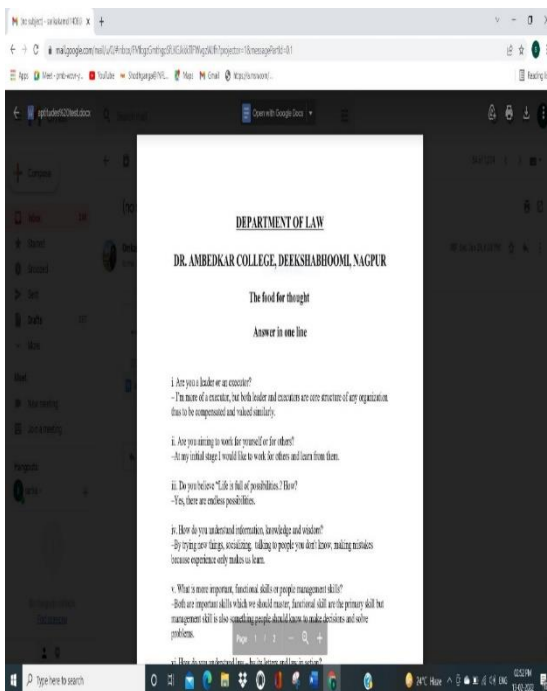
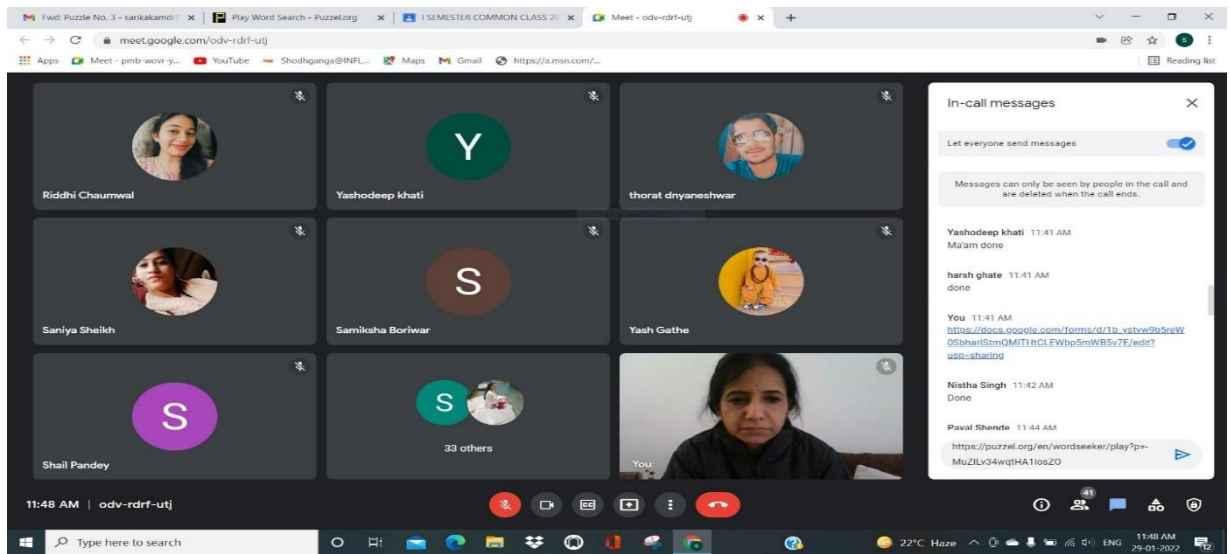

DAY 3 (28/2/2022) APTITUDE TEST, CROSS WORD AND CAREER ORIENTATION



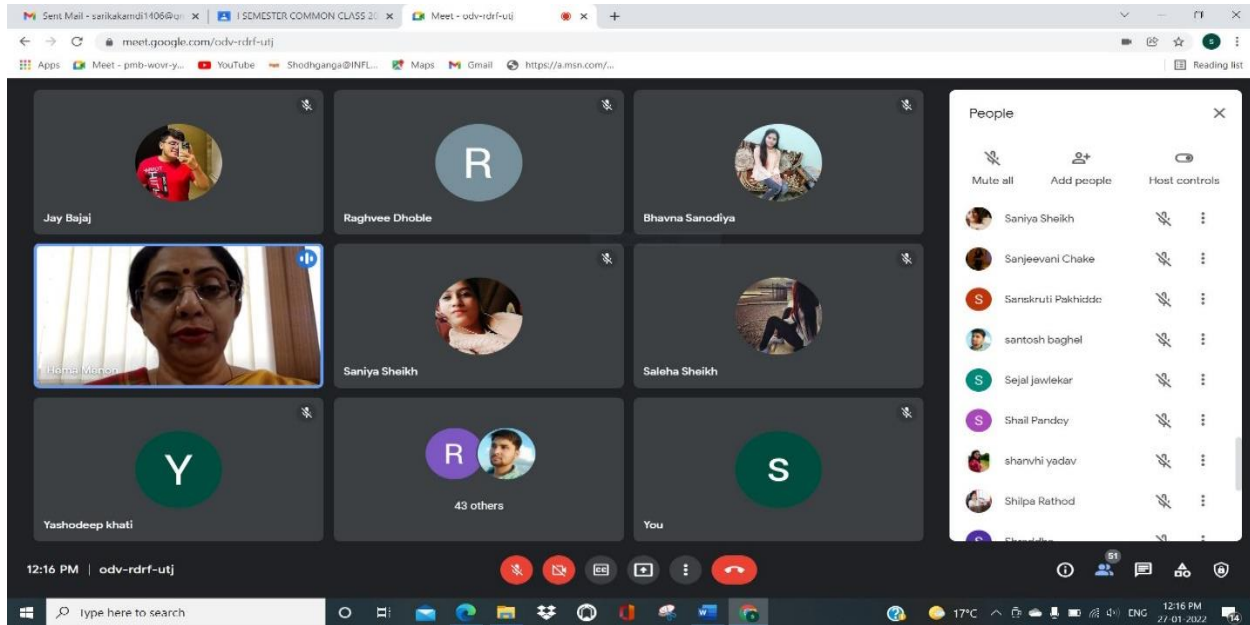

Advocate Wilson Mathew



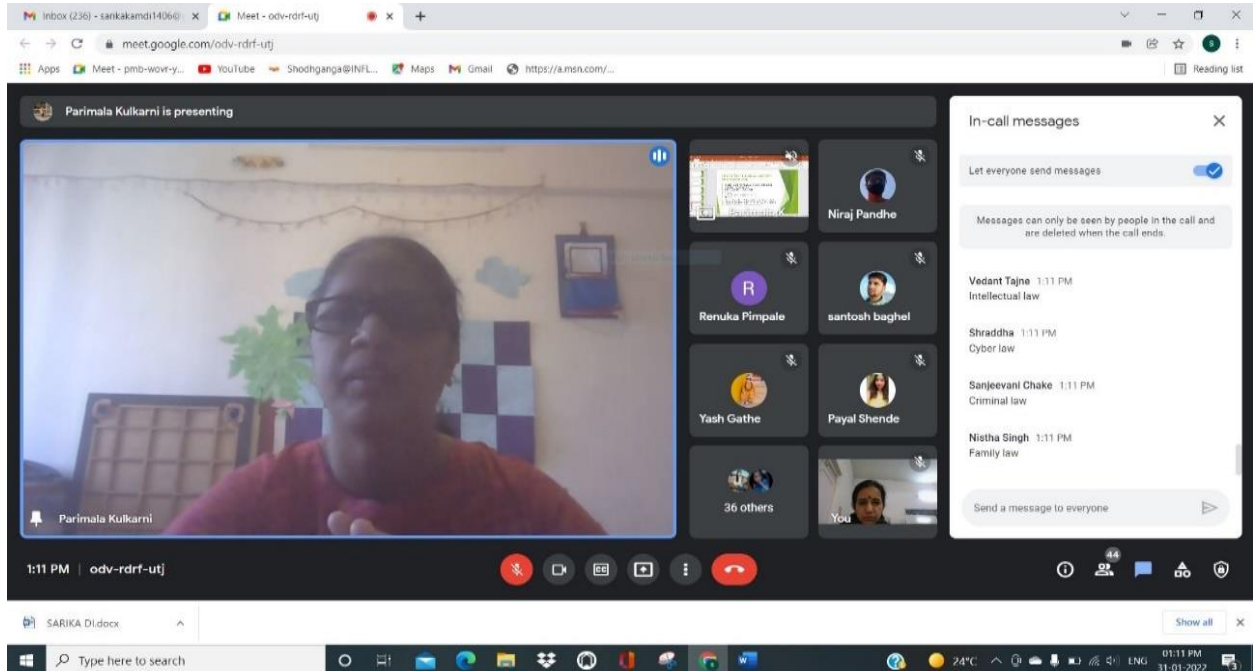

Adv.Parimala Deshpande-Careers in Corporates/Banks

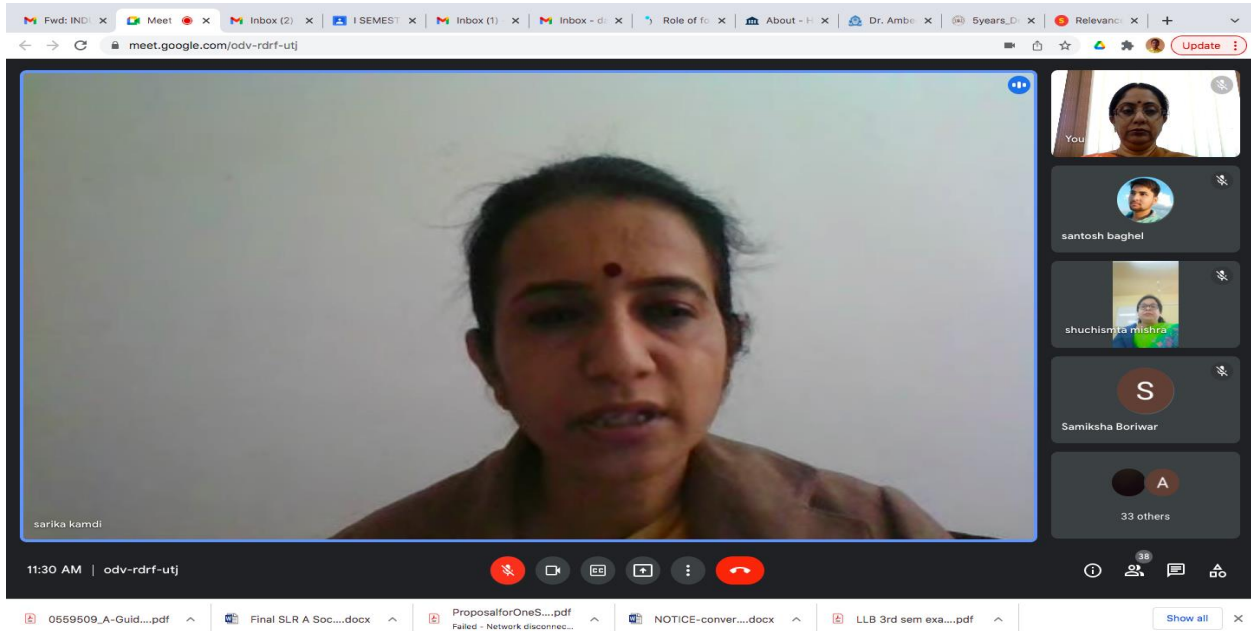

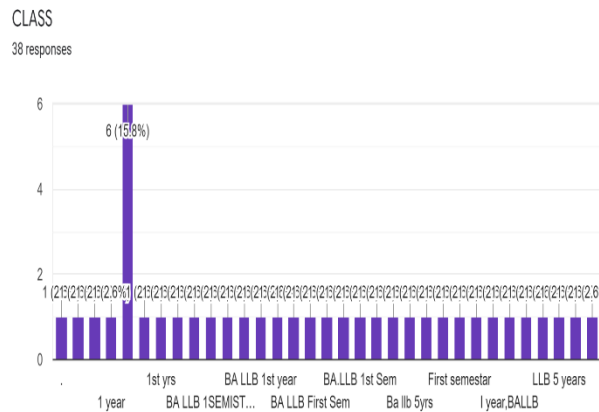
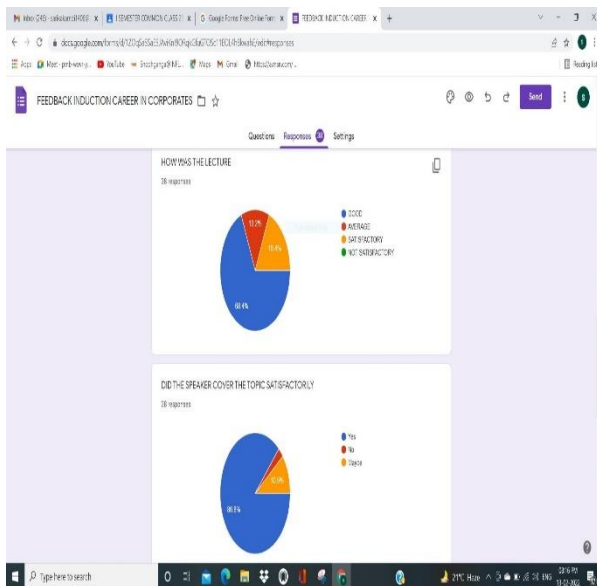
