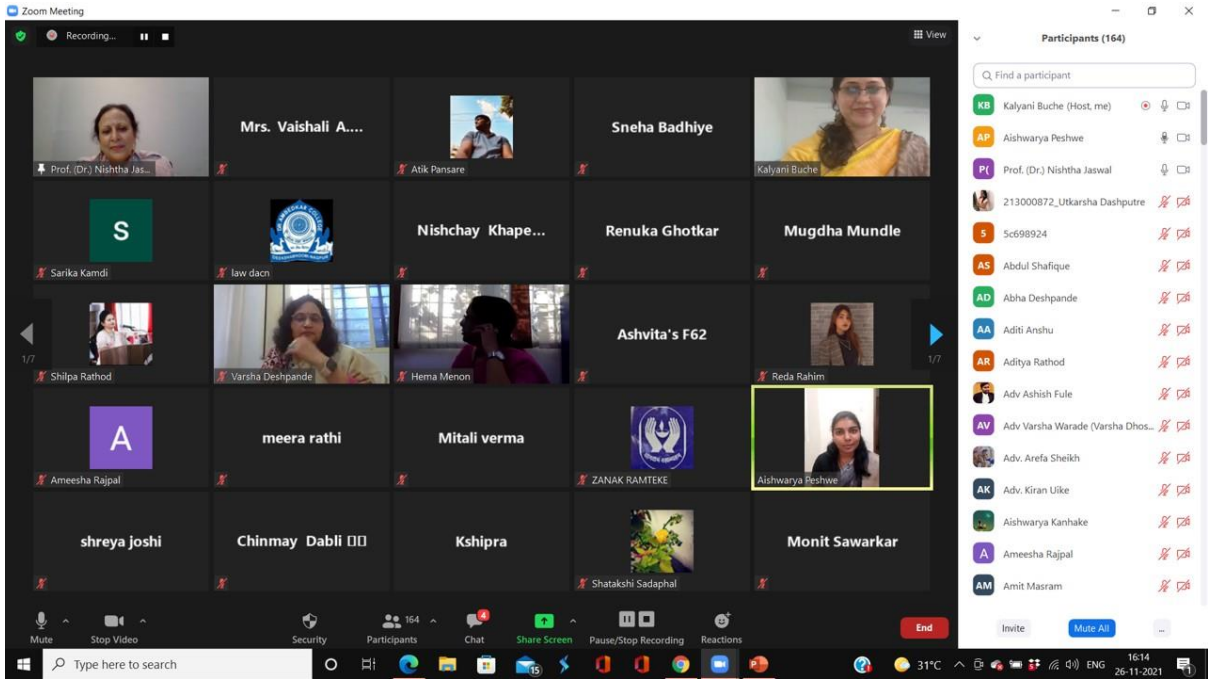

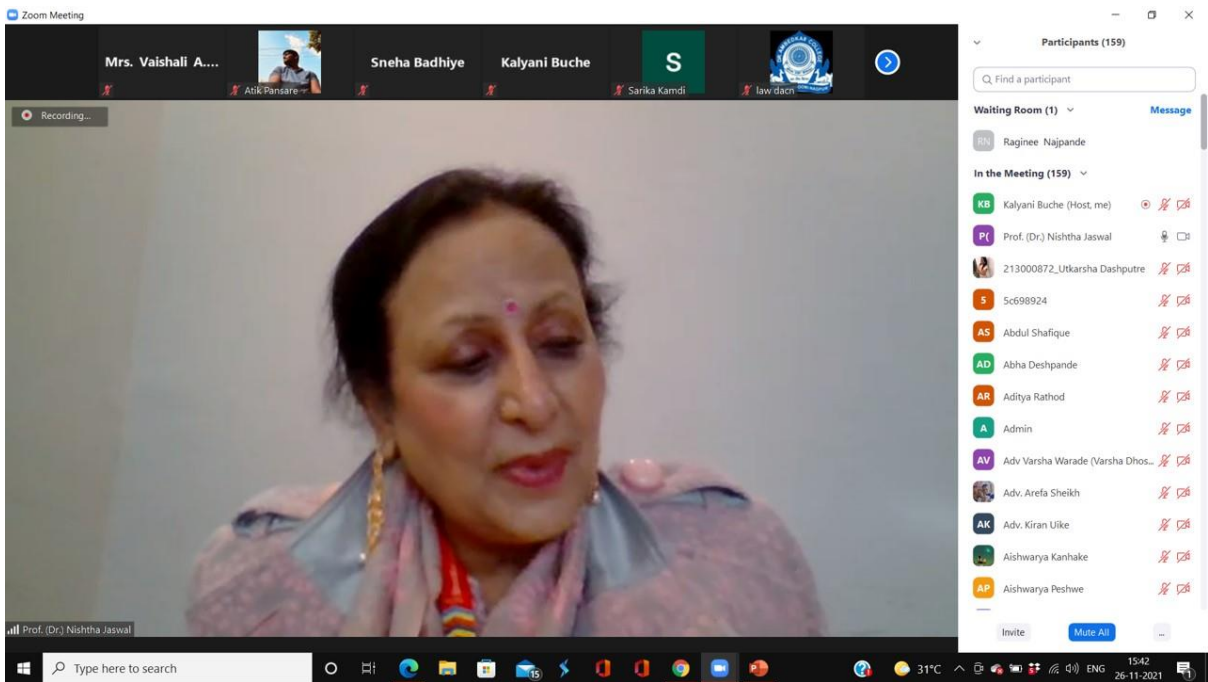

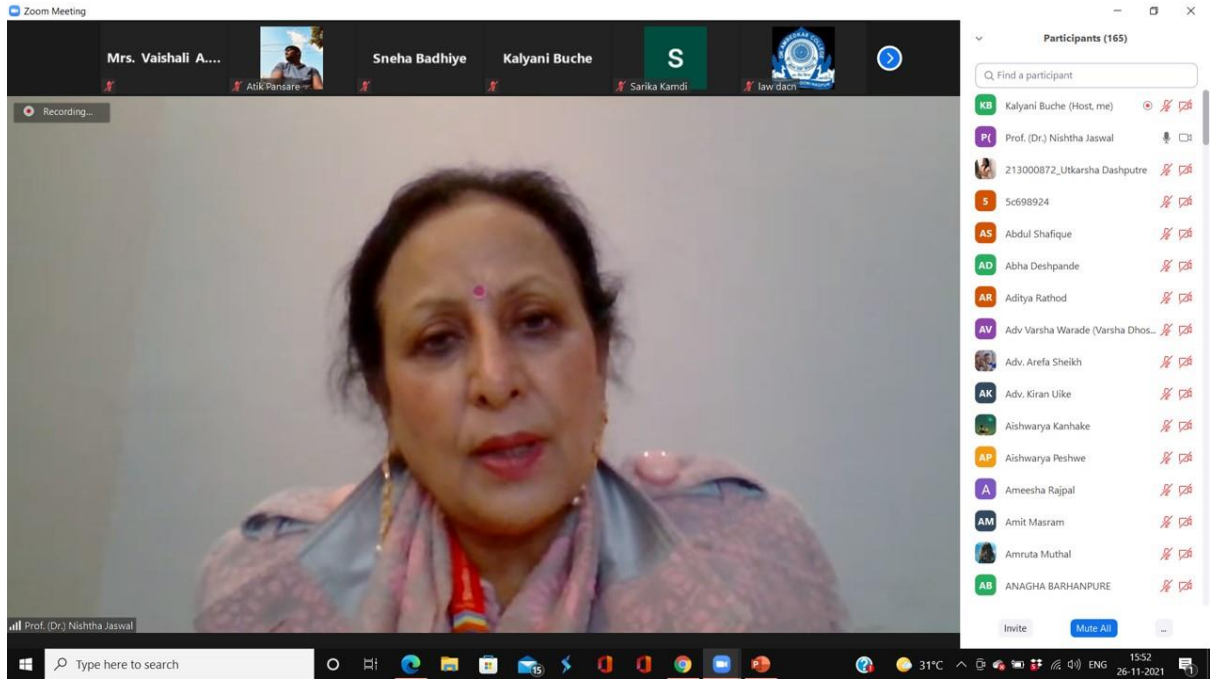


Dr. V V Deshpande, Associate Professor & Coordinator, the Centre for Constitutional Law & Public Policy Debate giving the opening address
