New Consumer Protection Act, 2019 was passed due to ambiguities and complexities in the Consumer Protection Act, 1986. It replaced the Consumer Protection Act, 1986. The new act was passed to strengthen consumer rights. The act defines six consumer acts namely right to safety, right to be informer, right to choose, right to be heard, right to consumer education and right to grievance redressal. The new Consumer Protection Act 2019 seeks to revamp the process of administration and settlement of consumer disputes, with strict penalties. It also envisages simplifying dispute resolution process, by Mediation and e-filing of cases. The need for empowerment of consumers as a class cannot be over emphasized and is already well recognized all over the world. There is an urgent need to promote General Awareness of the rights of the consumer by encouraging consumer education and supplying information.
