Topic : New Challenges in the Indian Constitution : An Overview

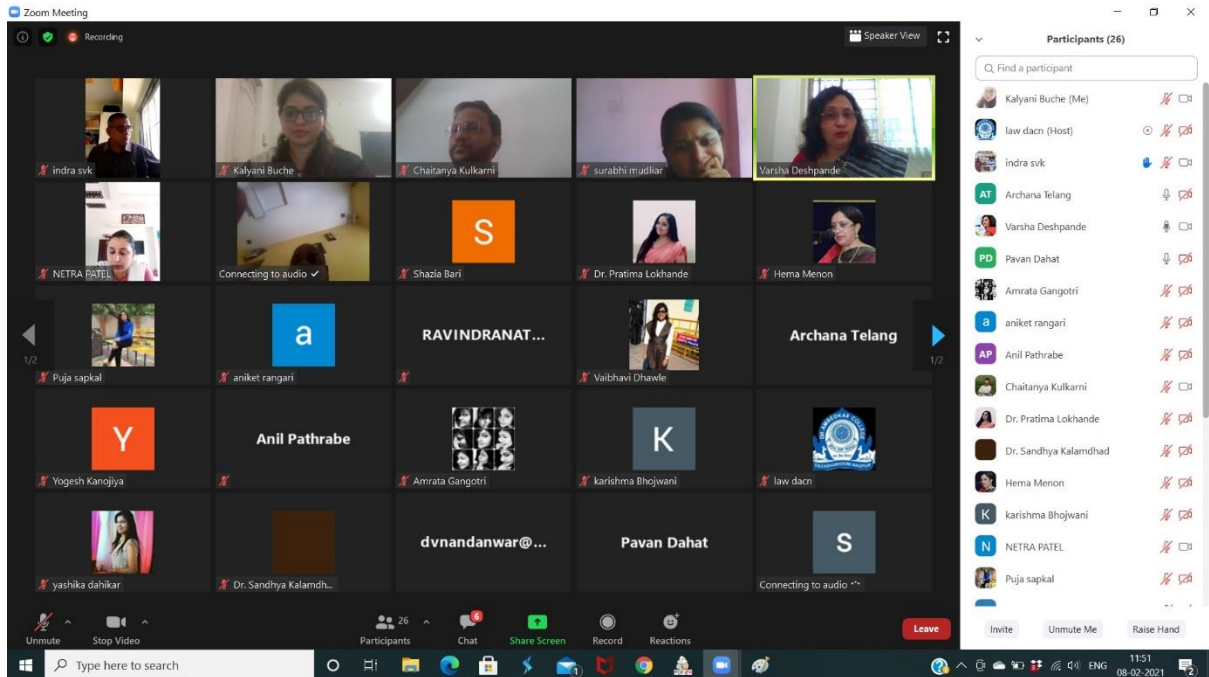
Date : 08.02.2021

Lecture on New Challenges in the Indian Constitution was taken for the newly inducted First Semester students of LLM 2020-21 batch on 08.02.2021. In this class a unique method known as **Collaborative method of teaching** was used. The collaborative teaching method facilitates the offering of different perspectives of different teachers to the students on the same subject at the same time. During the lecture senior faculty member Dr. Varsha V. Deshpande introduced the newer challenges faced by the organic and living Constitution of India, in the form of incorporation of various facets within the meaning of the definition of “State” under Art. 12 as well as the changing dynamics of meaning of “Law” under Art. 13 of the Constitution.

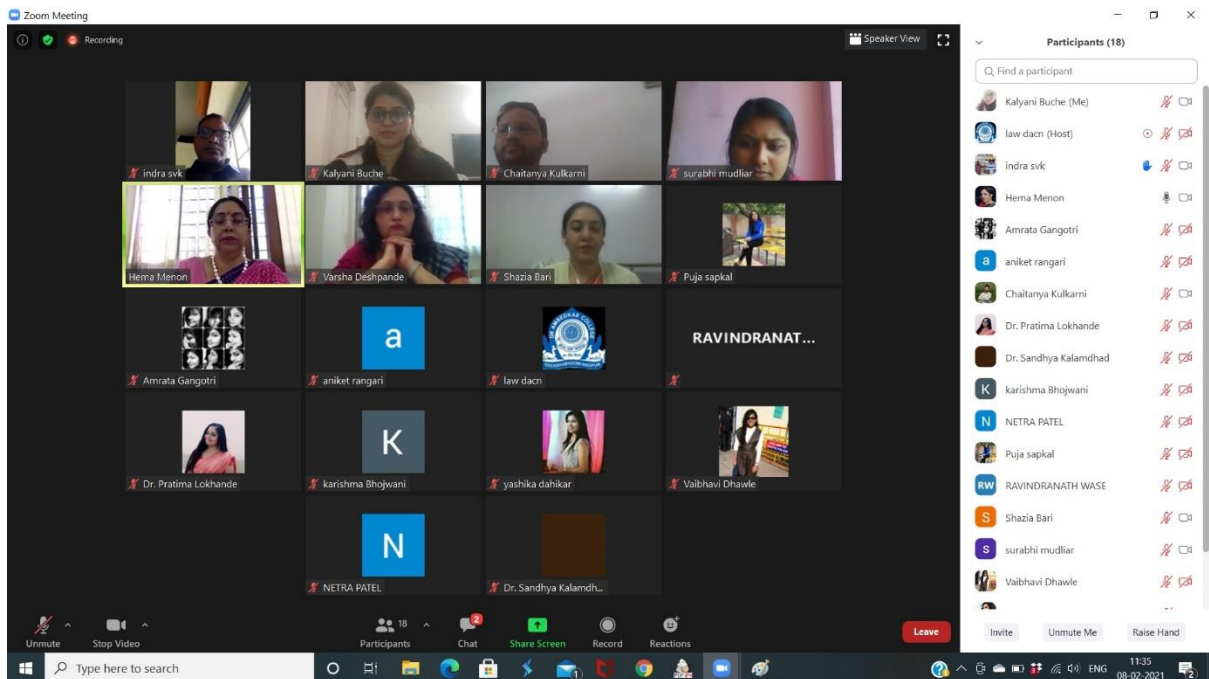
