“CRIME AGAINST WOMEN AND CHILDREN IN CYBER SPACE”

The resource person of the workshop was Dr. BishwaKallyan Dash, Assistant Professor, Nirma University, Insititute of Law, Ahemdabad.

The program commenced with the welcome address by Head Department of Law, Prof. Dr. HemaMenonto the well acclaimed Guest speaker, Dr. BishwaKallyan Dash, the faculty members of the departments, and treasured invitees.

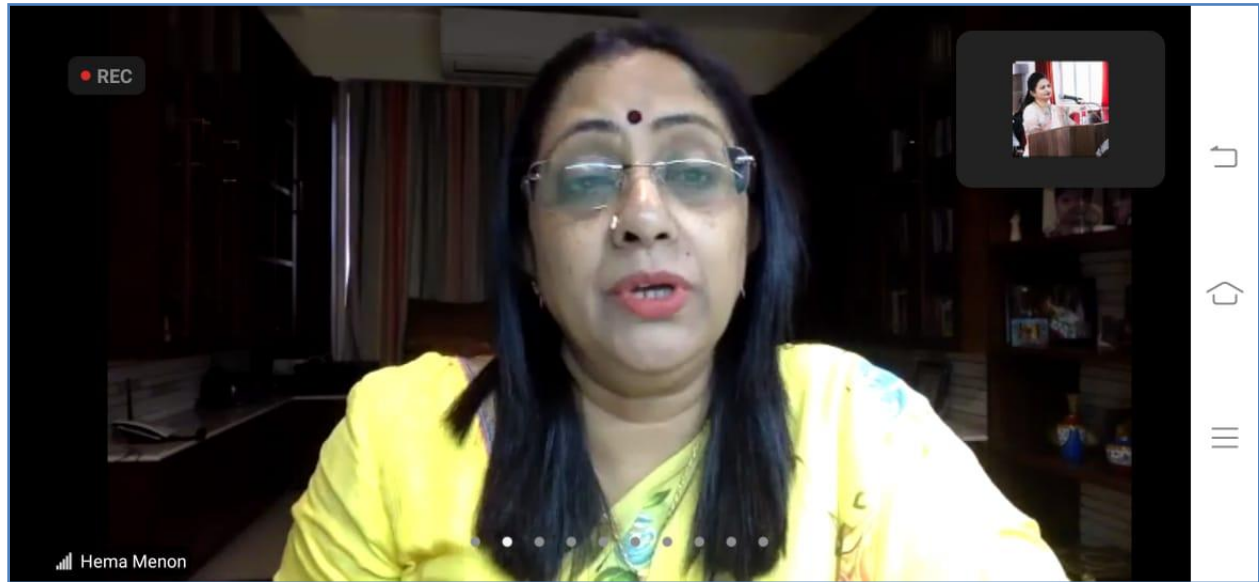
Dr. Bishwa Dash empathically explained the meaning of cyberspace and various forms of crimes in cyber space like Hacking, Cyber stalking, Botnets, Identity Theft, PUPs, Phishing and Prohibited/Illegal Content etc with the help of most relevant illustration in each domain. He has further explained all the relevant provisions of IPC, Information Technology and POCSO Act.

Dr. Bishwa very aptly and sensitively covered all the aspect of crime against women and children in cyber space. In his concluding remark he explained who is at fault in cyber crime? So the liability has to be fixed at different levels differently. He laid the emphasis on the Revenge Cyber offence by giving the example of renowned actor Sushant Sing Rajput.

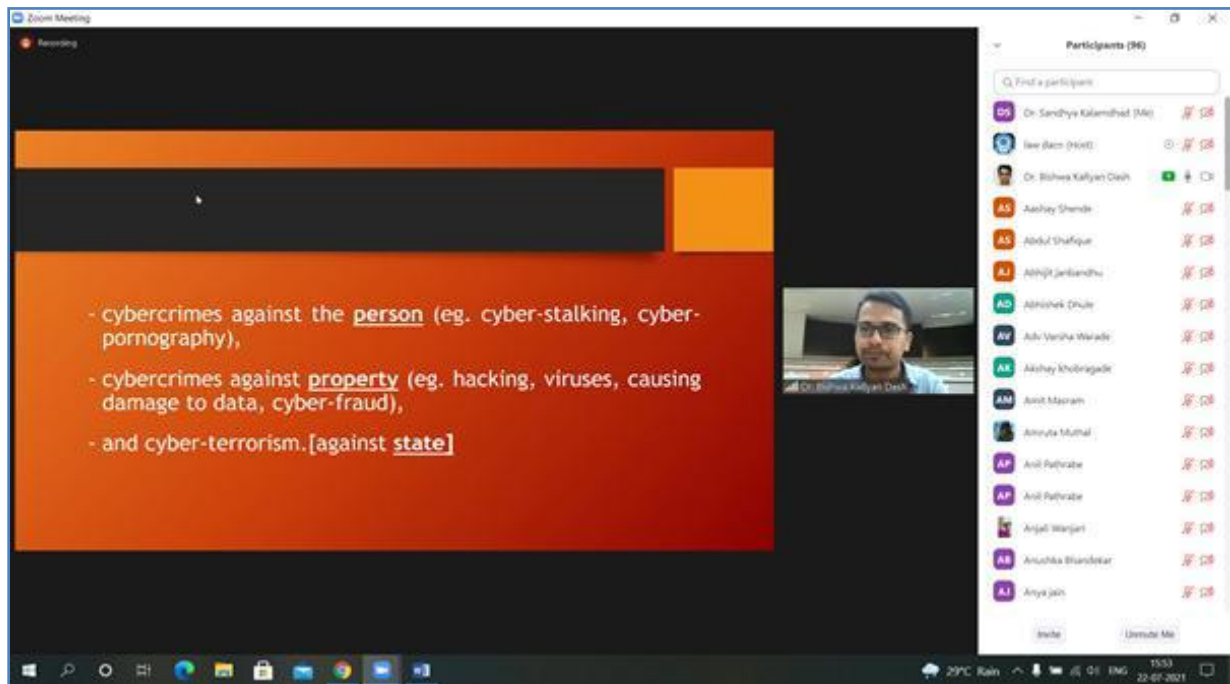

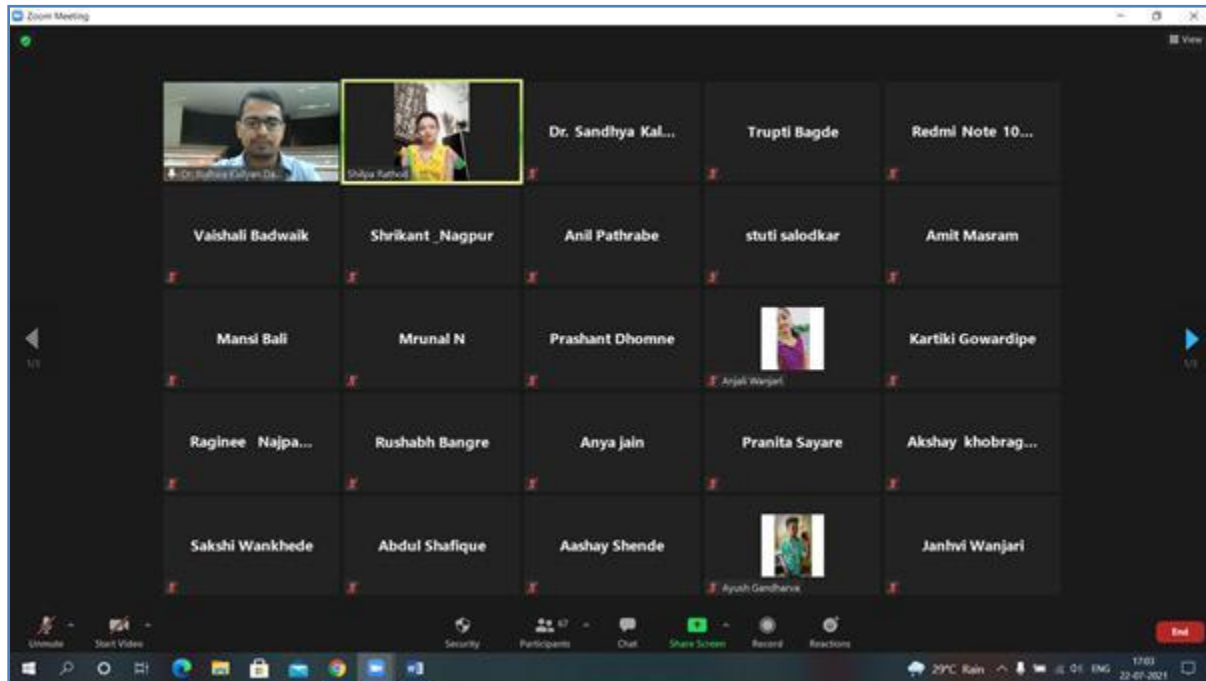
The event concluded with vote of thanks proposed by Ms ShilpaRathod to the Guest speaker and also to everyone who was present to witness the event.



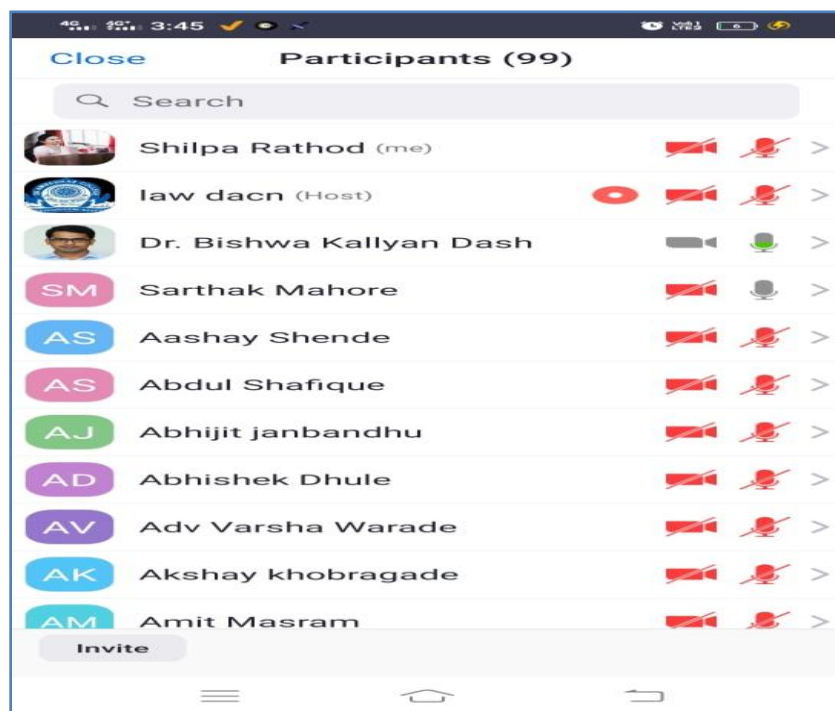
