On 12th May, 2021, an Online guest lecture was conducted by Dr. Ambedkar College, Department of Law, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur for the final year students of LLB VI Semester (3 years course). Total 50 students attended the program. The Program was conducted under the guidance of Prof. Dr. H.V.Menon, Head of the Department of Law, and Asst. Professor Dr. Pratima lokhande. Faculty Members, and all Visiting Faculties teaching in LLB VIth Semester (3years course) joined the online Program through Google Meet Meeting at 11.00 A.M.

About the speaker

Advocate Chetan Dhore is a law graduate from Dr Ambedkar College Deekshabhoomi Nagpur and with Gold medal in constitutional law in his masters (LLM) from Rashtra Sant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University.

Practicing as an Advocate in High Court of Bombay since 2010 and in different courts all over the India including different tribunals and the Supreme Court of India. Specialisation are drafting and pleading civil litigations, Public Interest Litigation, Writ petition under article 32 of the constitution.

He is imparting training to group A gazetted officers recruited under the Indian Ordnance Factories Act. Special command on arbitration and conciliation. He has been a mentor and guide for many judicial officers who are presently working as jmfc and district judges.

Objectives/ preamble

The objective of the online lecture was to focus on different Techniques of “Moot Court” where in the participants learnt the Step-by-Step approach to reading moot problems, researching with purpose, drafting written submissions and preparing for oral arguments.

The course content delivered in the webinar is as follows

“TECHNIQUES OF MOOT COURT: UNDERSTANDING THE PROBLEM, IDENTIFYING THE LEGAL ISSUES AND BASIC PRINCIPLES OF DRAFTING”

The speaker of the session Adv. Chetan Dhore presented the keynote address on “techniques of moot court: understanding the problem, identifying the legal issues and basic principles of drafting” and its importance in legal studies with best suitable decided case laws which were essential for the understanding of mooting techniques. He explained the various components of a case brief like relevant facts, issues. Contentions, law points, rule of law in detail during the lecture.

He discussed on the different aspect as to how to read and decipher a Moot problem for better presentation and focused on active reading, also told the student that one has to read the moot problem very carefully and decide which information is important to the result and which is not.

Also taught the student how to conduct preliminary research on moot problem. He also emphasized on how to conduct focus research for constructing argument. He guided the students on understanding the basic structure and style of Moot memorial, how to draft a memorial and to prepare the written memorial at different times.

Key focus was on identifying legal issues, how to prepare for the oral rounds of the moot and the different aspects of the moot round. How to respond to the question of the judges.

At the end of the session, he inspired the students by lively interacting on technicalities of good mooting.
