8. Decision of the Essay Evaluation Committee will be final.

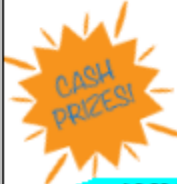

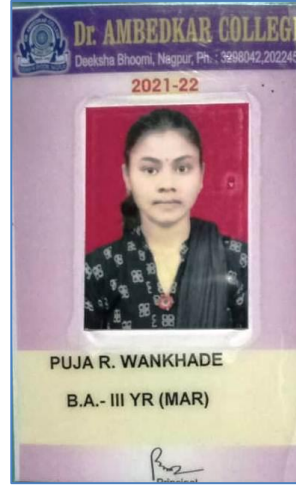
