




Walter H Pater

Who is Walter Horatio Pater?

- English essayist, art and Literary
 Critic
- 2. Two major works : A] The Renaissance B] Marius the Epicurean.
- 3. Proponent of Aestheticism
- Motto of Aestheticism: An Art for Art sake.



- 'Studies in the History of Renaissance' is a collection of essays based on the critical analysis of artists and their works belonging to period of Renaissance.
- Titles of essays included: 1] Aucassin and Nicolette, 2] Picco Della Minradula, 3] Sandro Boticelli,4] Luca Della Robbia, 5] The poetry of Michelangelo, 6]Leonardo Da Vinci, 7] The school of Giorgione 8] Joachim Du Bellay, 8] Wiclelman, 9] Conclusion.



 To find out the unique quality of an art that produced the impression of beauty and pleasure in the mind of onlooker.



ESSAY /: The School of Giorgione [Paters general observation about art]

Points laid out by Pater in following essay:

- 1] Different arts including Painting, Music, poetry are expressed via different sensory medium's hence not equivalent.
- 2] Role of art critic: To explain such distinction.
- 3] "All art aspires towards the condition of Music".
- 4] Lyrical poetry is closest art form to music where their is the least distinction between form and matter[content]
- 5] Giorgionesque: Represents a spirit which approaches this kind of identity of form and matter through its focus on Decorative [Colours, Lines and sensory details] For example:, subject include: People playing music, use of landscape and human figures.



Essay 8: Joachim du Bellay



- 1] A French poet and a critic who notably wrote a book
- ' The Defence of French language'
- 2] Called for, "The enrichment of French language by
- imitation and borrowing from the language
- literary form of the classics and the works
- Pater's observations about Du Bellay:
- 1] An important literary figure of French
 - Renaissance.
- 2] Softened the French literature by providing it with decoration and refinement.

- W Pater's observation about Johann Winckelmann:
- 1] Was interested in Greek Hellenistic culture and ideal[Just like Pater]
- 2] Hellenistic ideal: A free way of artistic expression and living.
- 3] Why a German art historians interest in Greek philosophy of free living?
- 4] Appreciation of Greek sculptures of Gods and perfect human sculptures. freely
 - expressed sensually without any burden of religion.
- 5] Greek sculptures freed the physical artistic beauty of human forms from shame.
- 6] Essay's end: Pater's view that modern world can't have this kinds



Pater's Famous 'Conclusion'

- Became infamous because people thought it might think it may call for Hedonism.
- Points out that inward world of thought stand in odds with physical world of action.
- Thinks that too much thinking and reflection in mind can be negative.
- An idea of art should be transformed into solid piece of Art.
