Department of Statistics Mentor – Mentee First Interactive Session Report 2020-21

The SCOP students were allotted to Department of Statistics for mentoring. The teacher of the department Ms. A. M. Badar worked as mentor. At the outset the purpose of mentoring was explained to them. They were apprised of the fact that the world is becoming more and more competitive and it is based on the principle of "survival of the fittest only". Therefore, it becomes imperative that one must be prepared for such situations.

The students were asked to fill up the specially prepared online google form for mentoring purpose. After receiving the responses from the students, the same were evaluated by the teacher.

The first "one to one" interaction of the mentors and the mentees on Google Meet was held on 28th November 2020 for final year students and on 6th December, 2020 for first year and second year students. It was observed that the students were hesitant to discuss their weaknesses but after friendly talk they opened up. Students of SCoP batches were mentored for the scholastic guidance, psychological guidance and development of personality. The mentees were given the necessary tips to overcome their weaknesses, to develop their personality and to enhance their strengths for making the best use of the opportunities. The personal problems which were hampering their improvement were also discussed and suitable guidance was given for overcoming these problems. Guidelines were given for improving their communication skills, computer skills, physical fitness, positive attitude, time management, for use of modern technology for upgrading knowledge, improvement of personality, contributing for betterment of society etc. Students were guided for improving academic performance in the university examinations. They are motivated for doing their studies properly by reading books on subject, magazines related to competitive examinations. They are motivated to improve their confidence level by participating in various competitions organized at department, college and intercollegiate level, listening to news etc. They are asked to keep good friend circle, to read good books like autobiographies of great persons, to keep cleanliness everywhere, to not to spend unnecessary time on mobile games and internet, to respect elders. Psychological support was also provided to them whenever required.

















Mentor – Mentee Second Interactive Session Report

2020-21

The feedback for any improvement in the students due to suggestions given in the first meeting was collected from the students in the second meeting which was held on 30th June, 2021. In the second meeting the students were more comfortable with the mentee. Some students frankly admitted that they got strengths to face the challenges of the life after attending the first session of the mentor – mentee interaction. Most of the students reported improvement. The following results which were found are encouraging.

- 1) Some students who were not attending the classes regularly started attending classes regularly.
- 2) The mentoring helped the students to study subject Statistics in a proper way and they scored good marks in university examination.
- 3) The students reported that their communication skills are enhanced by reading news-paper and extra books.
