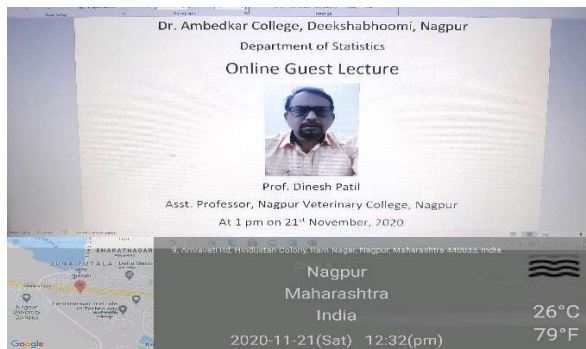

#### Interaction with Past Meritorious Students. (21<sup>st</sup> November, 2020)

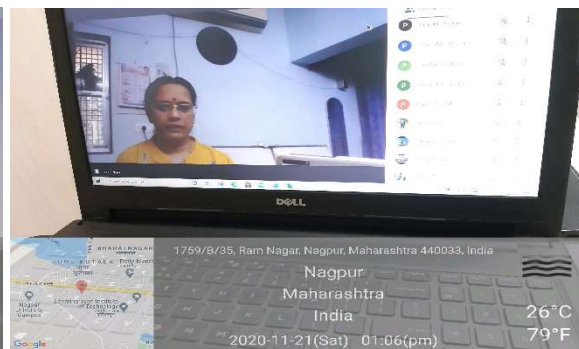

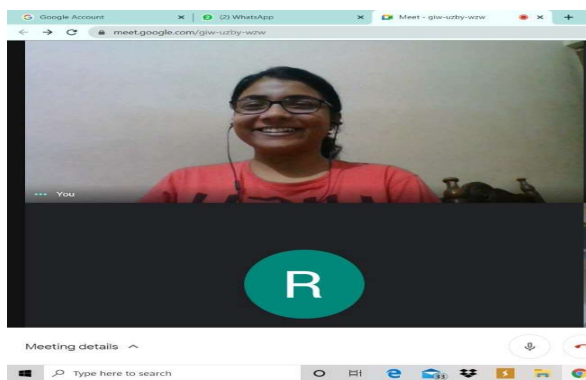

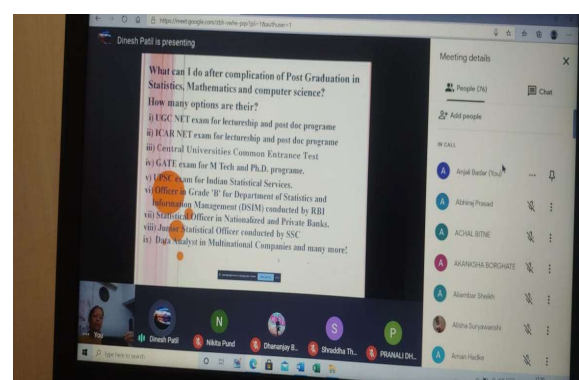
