Guest Lecture on Career Guidance and Job Opportunities by Ex Student. (27th March, 2022)

In today's competitive world the students are facing dilema while choosing a career after graduation. Many venues are availble about which the students are not aware. Hence it was felt that our ex-students can guide our present students about which career they should choose after graduation since they have gone through this phase themselves. Therefore, Department of Statistics, Dr Ambedkar College, Nagpur organised guest lecture of Mr. Prashant Dupate, Assistant Professor, City Premier College, Nagpur. Mr. Prashant Dupate after post graduate degree in Statistics joined IIT, Kharagpur for MTech. Course in Computer Science and Data Processing and completed it successfully. The guest speaker was introduced to the students by Ms. Yogini Raut of B.Sc. Sem VI. The programme began with a formal welcome speech by Mrs. A. M. Badar, Asso. Professor & HoD of DACN who also introduced the guest.

In all 45 students attended the program. He informed students that the subject Statistics offers great job opportunities in India and abroad because of importance of application of Statistics in different fields like in industries, agriculture, research, banking, finance, health sciences, government sector, private sector, different professional courses & other disciplines also. He talked at length how and why different organizations are picking up graduates with Statistics as one of the main subjects for employment in their organization. He emphasized that students of Statistics have a higher success ratio in cracking interviews because of their ability to analyse the data, information and draw valid conclusions from compiled information.

He gave information about various career options available to Statistics students after graduation. He gave detailed information about reputed companies who have requirements of students with statistical background such as TCS, Infosys, Insurance companies, manufacturing companies etc. Thereafter he gave information about making a career in govt. and corporate sector, opportunities available to Statistics students as Data Analyst, Bio- Statisticians, Data Scientist etc. The speaker introduced students to the vast number of opportunities which are available to the students of Statistics in India as well as abroad. He pointed out the large opportunities available for students as biostatisticians and data scientists.

He suggested some job areas for students like Medical, Cricket, Crime, Education, Census, Ecology, Election, Tourism, Film industry etc. He gave information that recruiters for statistics students are TCS, Accenture, Cognizant, RBI, HP, Deloitte Consulting, Neilson Company, Blue Ocean Marketing, BNP Paribas India, HDFC, GE Capital, HSBC, Indian Market Research Bureau, Genpact, American Express.

He informed students about use of different computer software for analysing statistical data and further recommended that the students should try and learn the use of these software to increase their employability. He stressed the importance of mastering the latest softwares such as Excel Statistical Package, WASP, R, JASP, SOFA, Scilab, jamovi, MacAnova and PAST etc. Students familiar with the use of softwares are

preferred in the selection process for the jobs. He gave information to students about books to be referred for NET and SET examinations so that they can make career in the academic field. The doubts of the students were gladly cleared by the guest.



Feedback received from the students for Career Guidance activity is as follows.

- 1) 81% students said that they came to know what are the avenues available for making career In Statistics.
