

Fresher's come to the college with an idea that it's a beautiful world where they will be welcomed and will be learning many good things. However, terrible things also may happen here. To have check on this every year we organises different programmes under the banner of Anti Ragging cell in our Institution.

This year the college organised a Workshop to create awareness regarding Anti ragging amongst the students of all faculty and especially for fresher's. Two years back we had introduced a buddy system in our college, where senior students acted as mentors for freshers. Continuing this tradition, in this workshop also senior guided the fresher's on different legal provisions as well as they narrated different stories to sensitize them as to why these practices need to be banned and explained the punitive scheme for ragging.
