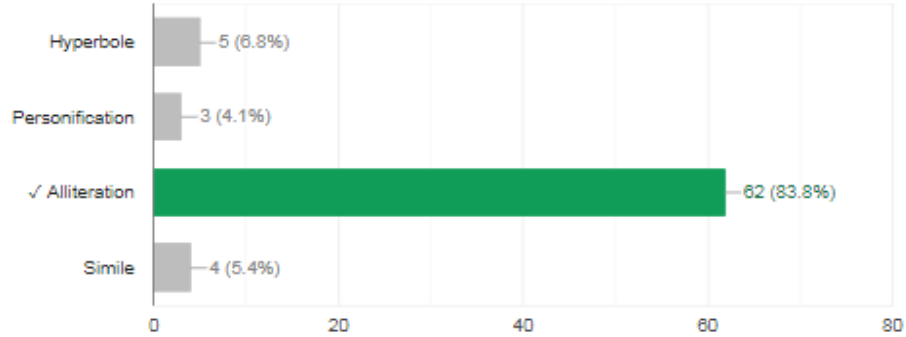

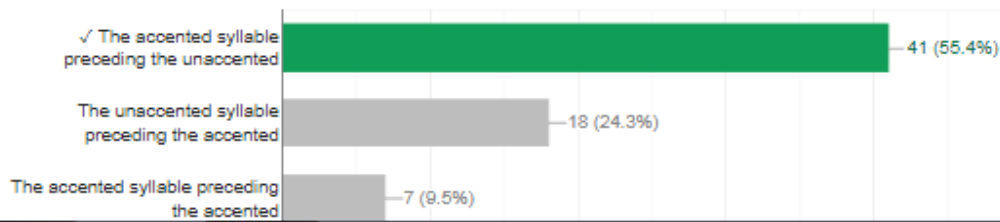
The repetition of the first consonant sound in words is:

"Falling Rhythm" is marked by

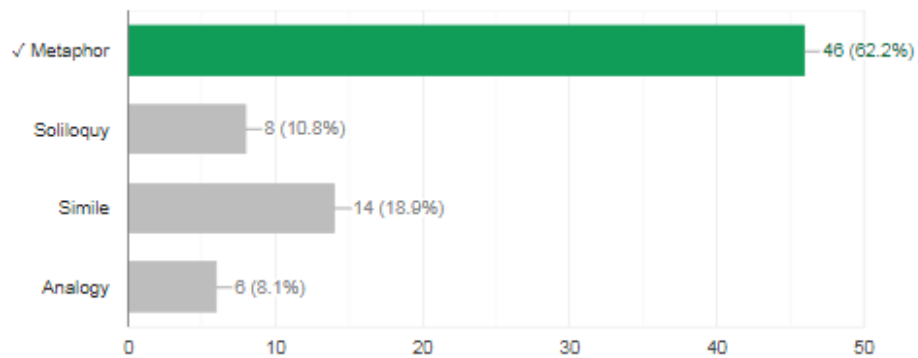

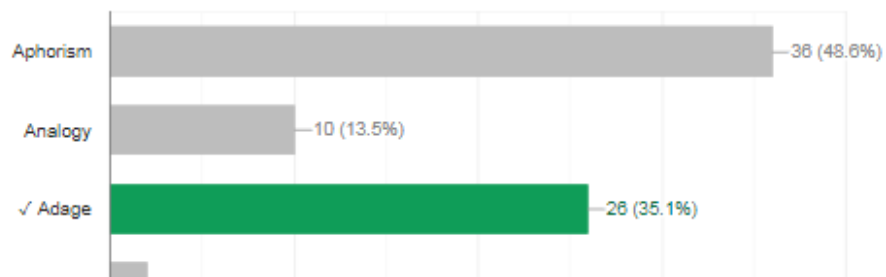
