A person with limited knowledge will not be able to share his knowledge.

Talking about online teaching learning, he said that physicality of teaching is so different to the virtual teaching and in this pandemic, online teaching is the best method to cope with the situation. If this pandemic had been in the past years, we would not be able to tackle as there was no such technicality in the past years. Online teaching has offered teachers an effective way to deliver lessons to students using tools like videos, PDF's, podcasts. Teachers have now become more efficient educators.

Very positively Col. Sunil Brijkrishansaid that if you have the ability to do something the world can't come to an end. Whatever kind of pandemic is there, we will face it. Talking about education, he said that education is discovering something new. Higher education is a quest for excellence. When we start developing new ideas, education acts as a catalyst.
