PREVENTION OF CYBER CRIME WITH EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE

DATE: 07 JUNE 2021

Human Resource Development Cell organized the 4th guest lecture of the series, online on "Cyber Security" on 07 June 2021 at 3 pm on ZOOM platform via Internet. The Resource Person for the lecture was Shri Amol DilipDond, Assistant Police Inspector at Cyber Police Station in Nagpur. The guest was introduced by Ms. Anita Tirpude, Assistant Professor, Department of English. Dr. Mrs. B. A. Mehere, Principal, Dr. Ambedkar College, DeekshaBhoomi, Nagpur in her welcome address said that cyber threat can come from many levels of the organization. It's very important to educate every individual about any type of cyber fraud. Cyber frauds are increasing day by day and are very dangerous as it is invading our privacy.

The Guest speaker Shri Amol Dond, APIinteracted on the topic Cyber Security in which he stressed on cyber-crime and emotions. Discussing about the different emotions and impacts, Shri Amol Dond said that there are two types of emotions: positive and negative and we must control both the emotions neither getting too happy nor angry. Addressing the teachers, he suggested that it is responsibility of every teacher to develop the emotional intelligence of the students wherein the teacher tries to develop the IQ of the students but only 20 percent is helpful to students. It's the emotional intelligence that helps the students. Further he said that the cyber fraud happens mostly with the educated people where the IQ will not work.

He then discussed on the various types of cyber-crimes and their effects citing several examples. He said that we have become very lazy and need everything without taking much effort and spending time. We should take out time in order to save ourselves from such frauds. Just like food, clothing and shelter are our basic needs, internet is also our important need now, but we must use it intelligently.

Lastly, he suggested that virtually we don't have to connect with each other rather connect with people face to face. He cautioned not to do online friendship, avoid downloading any unnecessary apps and spend time with friends and family.

Several questions were asked by the staff, which were very well answered by Shri Amol Dond. The program was conducted by Ms. Anita Tirpude, Assistant Professor, Department of English.
