The purpose of this guest lecture was to aware students on Autism Spectrum Disorder. The Chief speaker of this programme was Ms. Sweta Meshram, Clinical Psychologist, Nagpur. Principal Dr. B. A. For better understanding she start her presentation with definition of 'Autism Spectrum Disorder' which is given by American Psychological Association. She explained some symptoms of Autism and explained in a simple way. She stated that "communication of autistic children are different, children with Autism are unable to participate in two way

communication . She also stated some behavioural pattern , hypersensitivity to sensory input through vision hearing and touch. Has hightended or low senses of sight, hearing touch, smell or taste. She also talked about Myths, dietary habits and some treatment like behavioural therapy, speech-language therapy play therapy, medications to treats behavioural and emotional problems.
