Webinar by Mrs Geeta Nannaware

(Lecture hosted by Yatra)

A webinar on 'Forest and Wildlife' was organised online by the Yatra cell of Dr Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur on 13/10/2021 at 10.30 am. This lecture was held online on Zoom platform.

The lecture gave information about various forest and wildlife of Vidarbha of Maharashtra. Mrs Geeta Nannaware, the guest speaker is DFO Social Forestry, Nagpur and is Assistant conservator of Forest.

In the beginning he gave information about where the Forest are in India, Maharashtra and also Vidarbha region. She told that Nagpur is the Tiger capital of India and is also called the orange city. She gave in-depth information regarding various forest found near Nagpur. According to her there are about 5 forests near Nagpur. He showed various slides and beautiful photographs of forests which are predominantly found near Nagpur.

She told students about tiger population of the world and then the tiger population of Maharashtra and Vidarbha.

She then emphasized the need to conserve water, forest and wildlife.

At the end she gave a social message to conserve water, conserve forest and conserve our wild life.

In the last part she told about her experience of cracking MPSC which was very inspiring to let one think about collecting new information from every available resource. Also she emphasized to read newspapers every day and asked students to inculcate this habit.

She asked to plant at least one tree to everyone. She also asked everyone to love nature and save nature. She urged everyone to read more and more books and newspaper as well as increase general knowledge. She told about wild and foreign percentage of forest and their ratio and their present situation in our Maharashtra.

She also briefed about flora and fauna of Nagpur. The lecture was very helpful. She made students understand how we should save our environment. She told about Conserving tigers species, About wildlife of Maharashtra, About wildlife of Nagpur , Being a responsible citizen, Growing more trees, "where there is will there is a way"..... And importance of forest in our life, about the importance of forest wildlife conservation and how it has changed throughout the years.

At the outset, Principal of the college, Dr B.A Mehrewelcomed the guest and thanked herfor her spectacular presentation. She also briefed the students about the program Yatra and the importance of the program.

The session concluded with the questions being asked by the students.

The program was attended by about 92 students and teachers. All the students enjoyed the session because it was something new for them, which is out of regular syllabus. The students got in-depth information about various forests and wildlife of Nagpur. Coordinator of program Dr (Mrs) Aarti N. Wazalwar interacted with the guest speaker. The event was hosted by studentscoordinators of Yatra Himanshu Bathav and Kruti Tiwari. Kirti Jambhulkarintroduced the guest. Angelina Joseph proposed the formal vote of thanks.

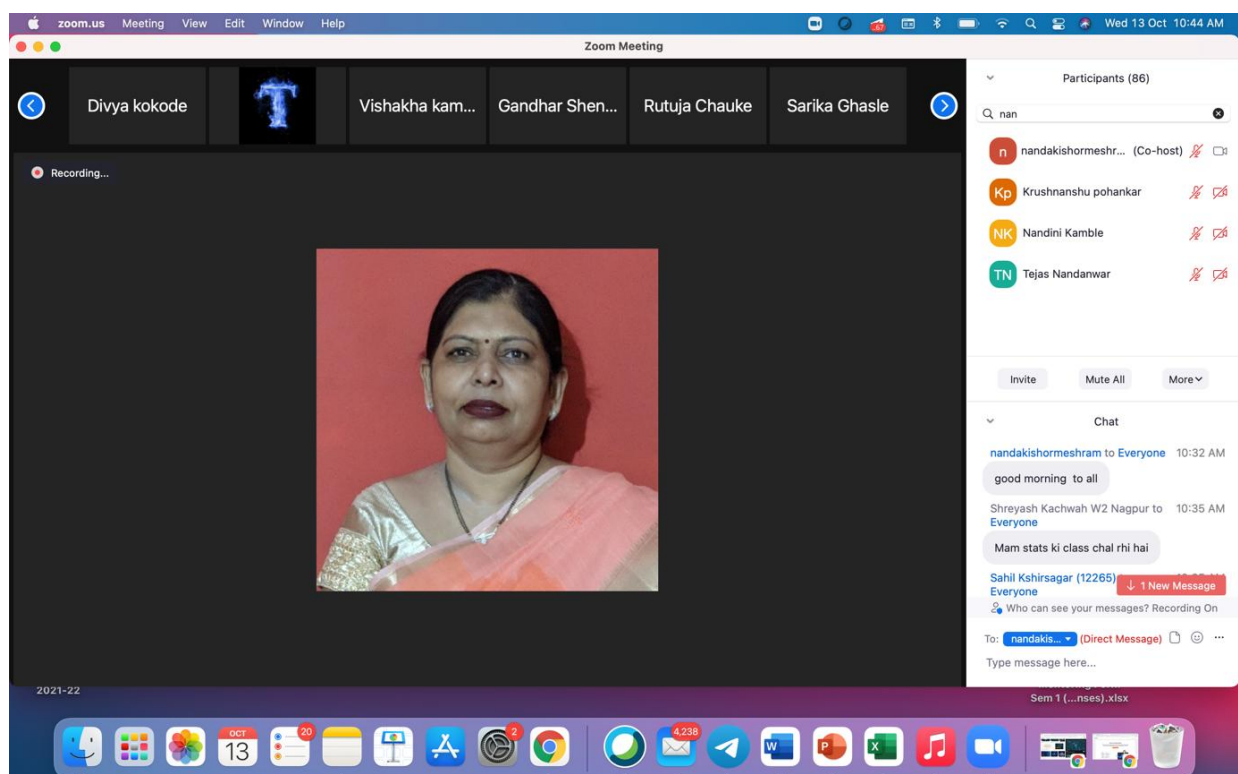
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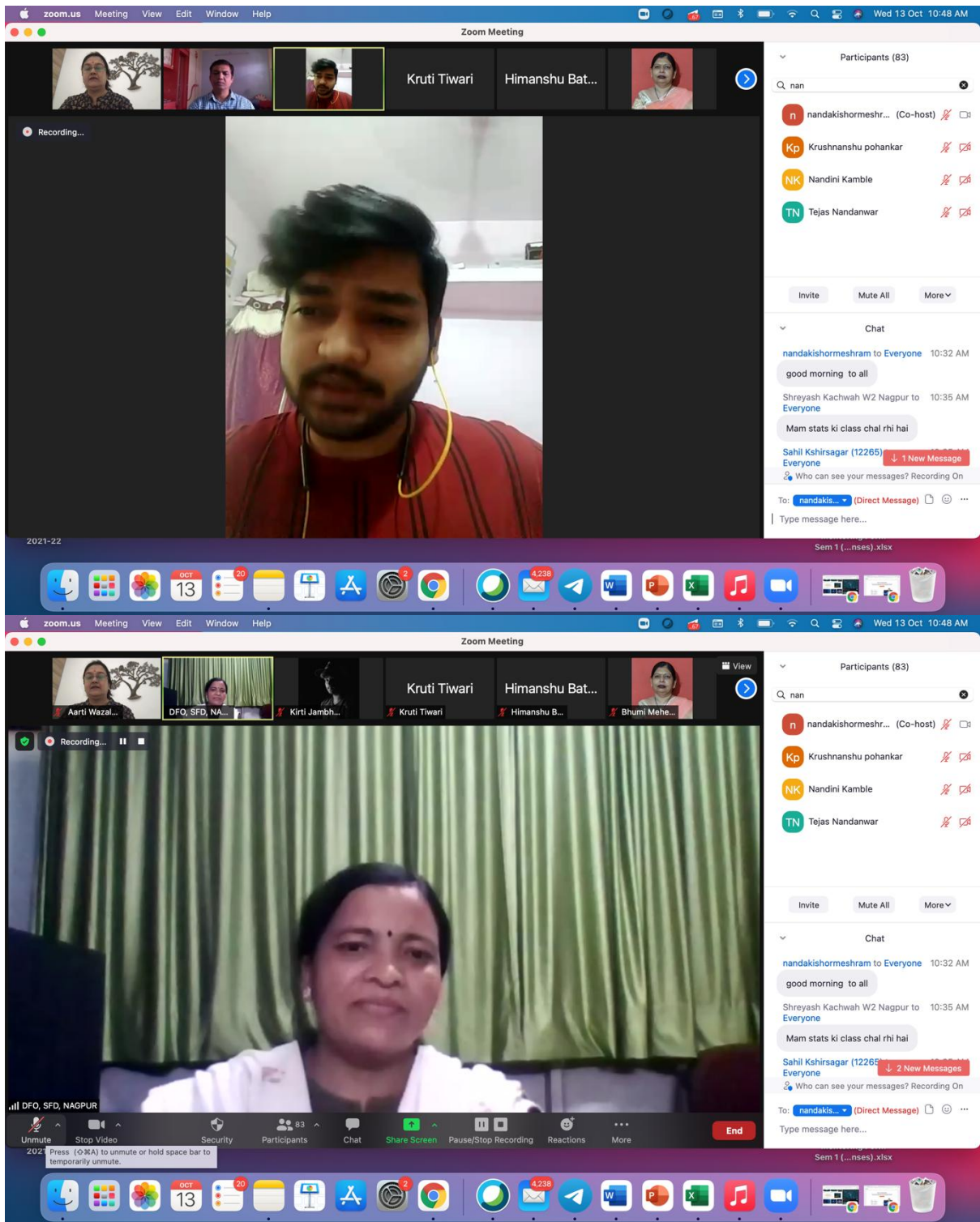

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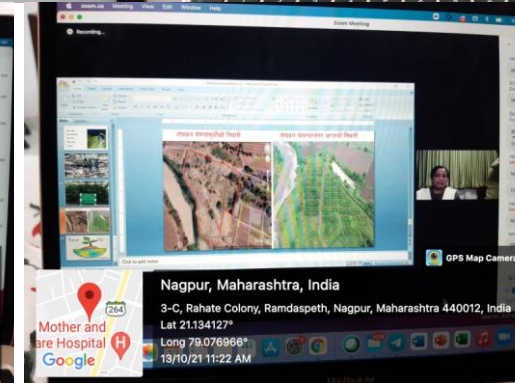
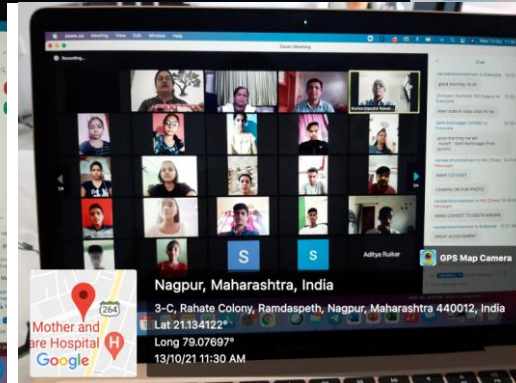
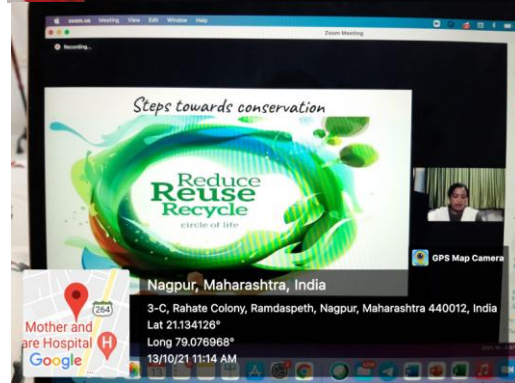
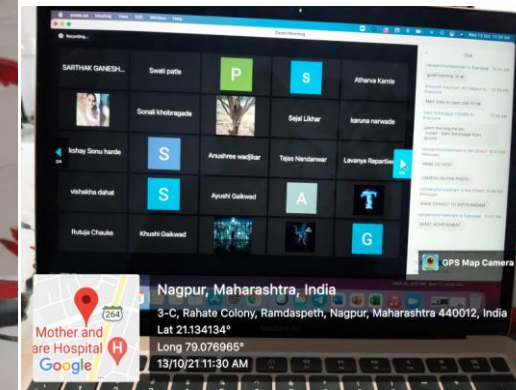
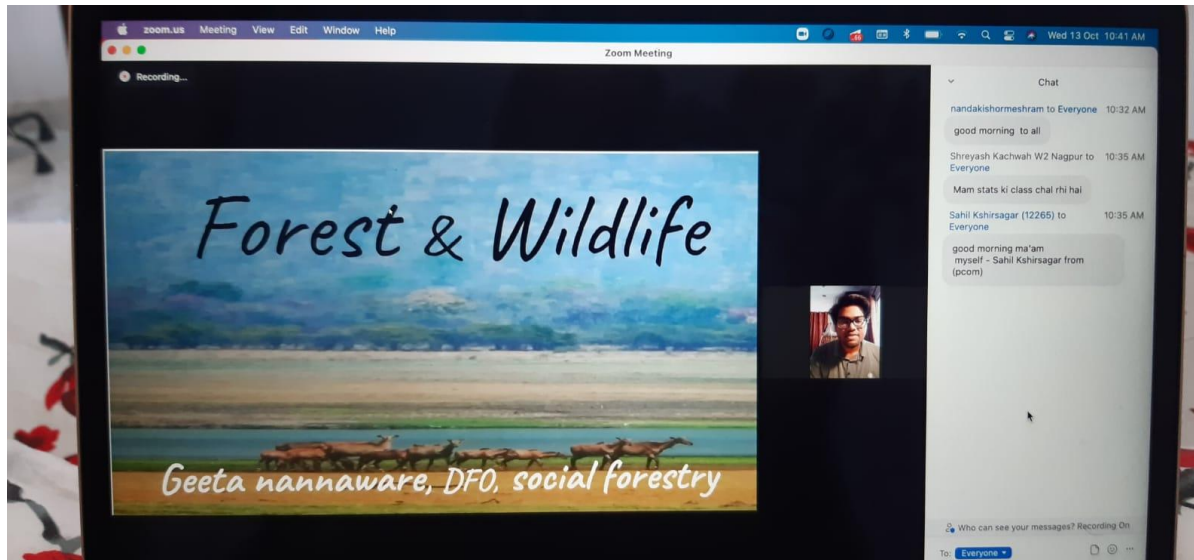
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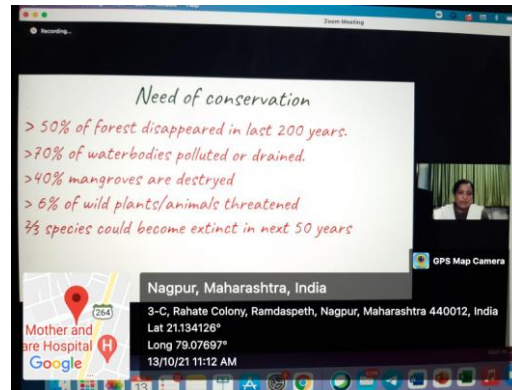
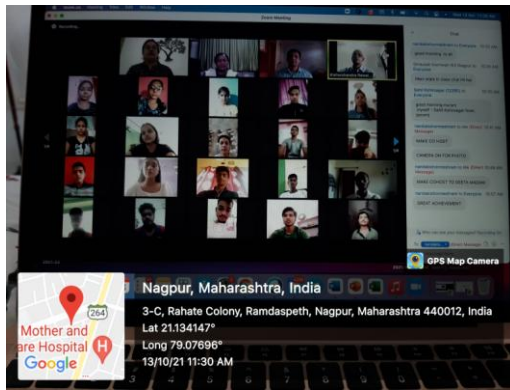
Need of conservation

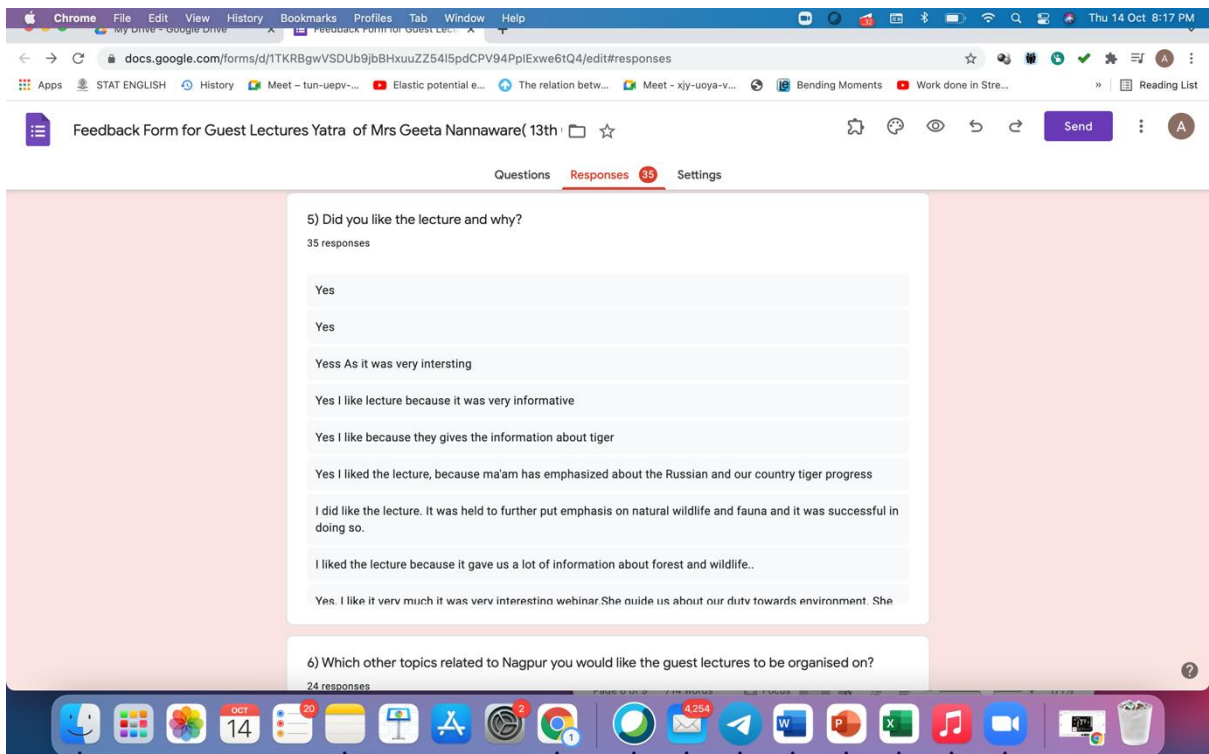
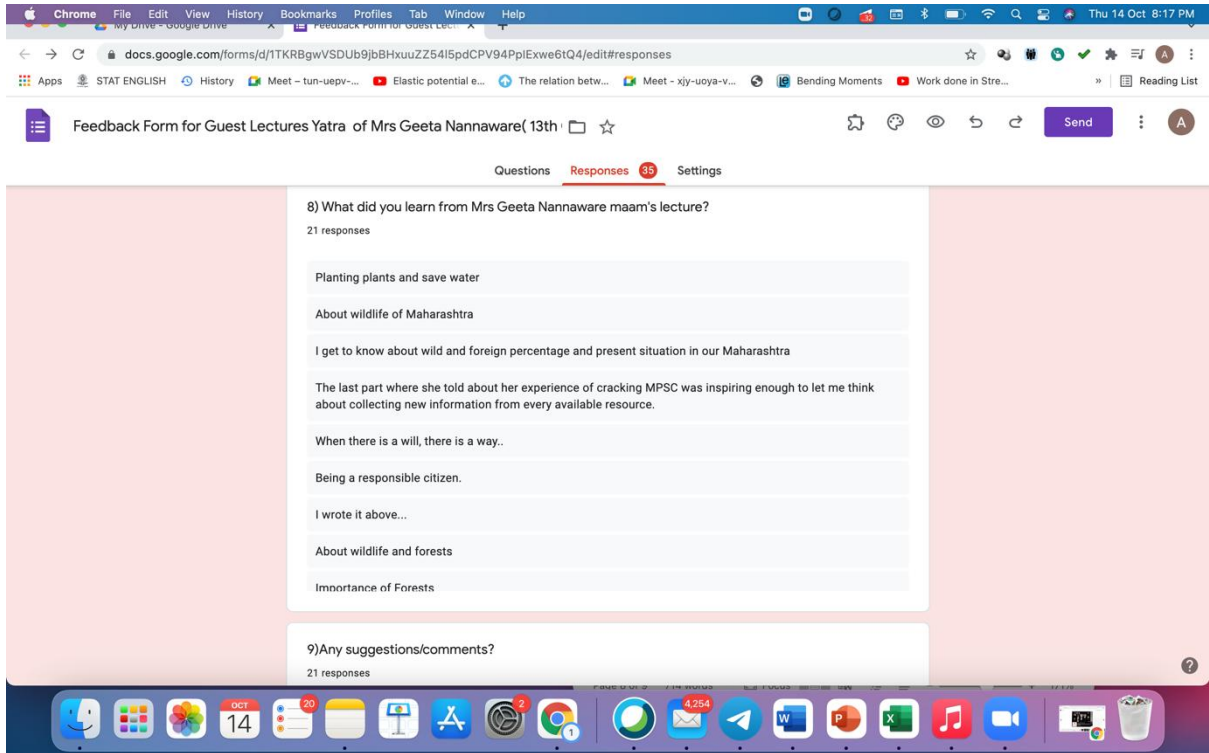
