#### REPORT

BCA department had organized workshop on "Making of Paper Bags" under the theme 'Say no to plastic' on 24<sup>th</sup> December 2019 at college auditorium. The chief guest for the workshop was Mrs. Shefali Dudhbade, accompanied with other guest members Mrs. Poonam Mishra and Mrs. Meena Dash. Mrs. Shefali Dudhbade serves on Social platform through Children Movement for Civic Awareness (CMCA). She also runs Campaign and small activities on Environmental issues in sensitizing the youth. In 2014 she started an NGO "SWACH ASSOCIATION" with a like-minded group of women to sensitize citizen on waste handling system bridging the gap between government agencies and common people to curb the problems on segregation systems, under this NGO she took lead to make waste management park in which they used different types of waste to beautify open spaces and on the same concept she created landscape artifacts in the premises of Modern School, Koradi road. She has taken lead to form a pressure group as ANVITI, taking lead to awaken public to bring Massive Movement and tough fight against plastic. She is also taking initiative in extending her help to various Anathashram and Vrudhashrams where they don't get government aids. The main objective of this workshop was to make Students and Staff aware of the bad effect of polythene bags on environment, human beings and animals.

In her lecture, she said that Plastic is bio-non-degradable product and can't be eliminated without damaging the environment. When eatable things are carried in Plastic, the chemicals get mixed with them; So Plastic bags make the food items poisonous. If the animals chew them, they go to their abdomen and causes severe pain and most of the time become a strong reason for their deaths. She further added that Plastic bags cause drainage problem and make the city ugly. The 80% of the total garbage is made of Plastic bags.

She also added that instead of using these plastic bags, people must go for bags made of cloth, paper and jute. She gave various other alternative for plastic bag like Use biodegradable Bags made from fabrics, Ladies can fold a cotton bag or two in to their purses which can be used

to quench their sudden urge for shopping, Donate old newspapers and magazines to small scale institutes that cut these old papers in to paper bags and packets, Offices can distribute canvas bags as New Year gifts instead of diaries and other sweet nothings.

Importance of paper as an alternative to plastic was explained to the participants Students and Staff by the guest followed by demonstration and practical training. Each participant brought their own material, information about different types of value added paper products including news paper bags, gift bags and gift envelopes of different types. The sole reason of undertaking this initiative was to make students understand the harm caused due to plastic bags and to encourage them to replace plastic with paper bags. Students prepared over 80 paper bags thereby spreading the message of "**SAY NO TO PLASTIC.**"

At the end of Workshop a feedback session was conducted in which all the students have taken part with enthusiasm. Total of 114 Students attended the workshop from College. Nitin Ranhagdale student from BCA -Sem VI compered the workshop, Arbaaz Din, student of BCA -Sem VI proposed a vote of thanks. The Workshop was co-ordinated by Dr. Prakash Bhongade and assisted by Mrs. Priyanka Soitkar, Mrs. Anuradha Bhattad, Ms. Shama Khan. The faculty members Dr. Prashant Yende, Dr. Harshala Pethe and Mr. Vaibhav Bhagwat also attended the session. The Event was successful and it rightly benefited all those who attended it.
