“Study Counselling and distribution of Educational Aids and Material to Economically Weaker Students”

Social Outreach Cell, Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur

The counselling specialty concerned with providing advice and assistance to students in the development of their educational plans, choice of appropriate courses, and choice of college or technical school. Counselling may also be applied to improve study skills or provide assistance with school-related problems that interfere with performance (e.g., learning disabilities). Educational counselling is closely associated with vocational counselling because of the relationship between educational training and occupational choice. Also called **educational guidance; student counselling**. An Educational Counsellor mainly works with school and college students in academic environments. Many schools have their own educational counsellors to help students find the right career and make informed choices in their studies especially special needs children and educational counsellors also assist students in dealing with the personal issues impacting their academic journey, to resolve such issues and Educational Counsellor also interacts with the student’s parents or guardian or teachers to help them in figuring out the best solutions for the student’s problems.

An Educational Counsellor takes care of a lot of things more than just education. Here are some of the other concerns that Educational Counsellors need to take care of: Family Issues, Puberty related questions, Advice on educational and career choices, providing familial support, Transportation problems, Concerns regarding grades, Bullying or Fighting.

As most of the schools do have counselling sessions for their students but the unprivileged children of slum areas studying in public schools and coming from a very poor background are unaware and do not have this facility at their school level. Social outreach cell, Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur had conducted a “**Study Counselling and distribution of Educational Aids and Material to Economically Weaker Students**” organized for the unprivileged children of slum area near Manavta Vidyalaya Babhulkheda, Nagpur in Bhim Jyoti Buddha Vihar with association with NGO-Vardaan on 27th April 2022 at 10 am. In this program Mr. Pradip Hirapure, Member, Social Outreach Cell gave counselling sessions to the participants and educational aids and material like table book, log book, white board etc were distributed to the participants along with the refreshments.

The coordinator of the cell Mrs. Shweta Paranjape and all the members of the cell Ms. Swati Chimurkar, Mrs. Shama Khan and Ms. Rohin Meshram were present in the program. Around 53 participants which includes 45 girls and 8 boys were present. A total of 12 volunteers of Social Outreach Cell 7 girls and 5 boys were present to coordinate the program.
