The birthday of Padma Vibhushan Dr. P. C. Mahalanobis, which has been declared as National Statistics Day by Government of India, was celebrated in Department of Statistics on 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. Principal of our college Dr. (Mrs.) B. A. Mehere was the Chief Guest of the function which was largely attended by the students. Principal madam lighted the traditional lamp to mark the beginning of the function and garlanded the portrait of Dr. P. C. Mahalanobis. Mrs. A. M. She also told students that Dr.P.C.Mahalanobis took major responsibility of drafting second five year plan for India and how he contributed immensely towards development of India.
