
It was followed by the guest speaker of the function Dr. Mr. Manchak Ipper (IPS), Joint Police Commissioner, Pimpri-Chinchwad, Pune. The guest speaker was introduced to the gathering by Dr Nareshchandra Katole , Director, Mission IAS. The speaker was then invited to deliver the talk. In his address he stated that The challenging Civil Services Examination (CSE) conducted by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) is spread over an entire year, divided into three extremely competitive stages, in which anything can go wrong at any stage leading to one's failure and it is necessary for the students that they should maintain positive mindset while appearing in the examination. Further he explained about the myths and misconceptions about civil service examinations which have no relevance in reality. Students also come across various myths about UPSC exams which some time give them cold feet during their UPSC examinations. He later added to this point that, UPSC examinations are most popular exams for

getting into the government services. A lot of students aspire to become civil servants and crack IAS, IRS, IPS and IFS someday. So keeping in that mind UPSC demands a lot of hard work and patient from the aspirants and that is reason it is to be said that UPSC exam is hard nut to crack because the passing percentage in the UPSC exam is only about 0.2% – a very dismal number indeed.

The guest speaker, later, briefly touched upon the intricacies of the examinations such as the qualifications, number of attempts, reservations, cut-off marks and the total number of services that comes under it., He stressed that rigorous training; systematic planning and hard work are the keys to facing the entrance exams. He finally concluded by stating that the exams are tough but not impossible to crack.

Mr. Praveen Khandawe, Technical Director, Mission IAS, was also present for the session In his address, he said that a lot of counseling and guidance is needed to the students before the examinations. He gave utmost importance to various factors resulting in the success or failure in any kind of competitive examinations or at the beginning of a professional career.




