**“Basic Awareness of Intellectual Property Rights - Patents”**

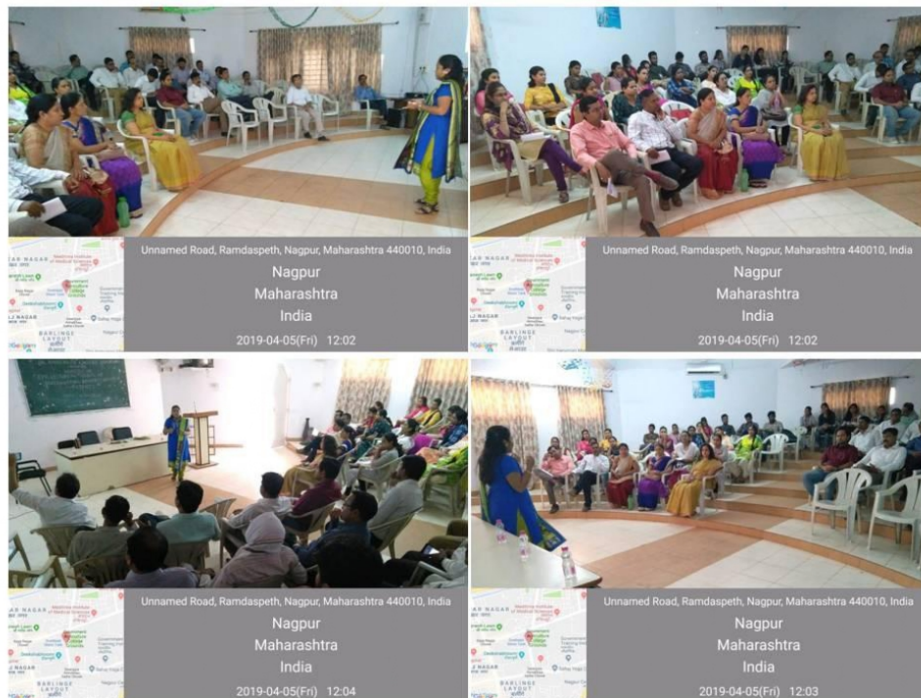

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Dr. Ambedkar College Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur organized the first lecture on “Basic Awareness of intellectual property Rights -Patents” as a part of the IPR Workshop Series on 5<sup>th</sup> April 2019 at 10:30 AM in the Mini Auditorium. The lecture was delivered by Mrs. Pooja Vishal Maulikar, Examiner of Patents & Designs, Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Intellectual Property Management, Nagpur and was ment for creating awareness amongst the science teaching faculty about IPR. The session was chaired by Dr. Mrs. Hema Menon, Coordinator IQAC, DACN. Around 30 teachers from faculty of science attended the lecture. Dr. Menon gave introductory remarks on the IPR workshop series and pressed upon the importance of this series to the faculties who are actively involved in the research activity. Dr. Deovrat Begde Asst. Prof Department of Biochemistry and IQAC member introduced the guest speaker to the audience.

The guest speaker Mrs. Pooja Maulikar began her presentation with direct interaction with the faculties and elaborated on the difference between invention and discovery. She informed the audience about the outline of the intellectual property right office and emphasized it as a powerful source of information in the country. She threw light on the concept of property stressing on intellectual property and its significance and different types. She made the audience aware of the IPs they are surrounded in their day to day life like from paper clip to ballpoint

pen. She informed them about the 31 Designs and 37 Patents involved in making of Nano car bay Tata group of industries suggesting the significance of patents and designs. She elaborated on the patentable and non-patentable products mentioned in Section (3) of Patents Act, 1970 and Patent filling method in India. Mrs. Maulikar kept the session interactive by constantly interacting with the faculties and answering their doubts regarding patenting and other IPs. She also informed them about the detail workshop conducted by Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Intellectual Property Management, Nagpur and how DACN faculties can contribute in nation development by creating patentable invention and other IPs.



# **“Promoting entrepreneurship among young graduates” from Problems to Solutions**

Department of Botany, Chemistry, and BCA jointly organized a seminar on 18<sup>th</sup> Feb 2019 on “Promoting Entrepreneurship among young graduates.” The guest speaker was Dr. Bhimrao Ghodeswar, Ex-Dean Professor, (NITIE), Mumbai.

The programme started by observing two - minute silence for Pulwama martyrs. Dr. Bhimrao Ghodeswar was welcomed and introduced by Dr Deepa Panhekar. Dr Ghodeswar gave information about various qualities required in a person to become a successful entrepreneur. He explained by giving examples how business ideas can be worked upon considering local problems and resources available. He gave examples of successful businessmen who started from scratch. He emphasized on the early struggle of these businessmen and the adversities they faced and overcame. He gave references of several traditional businesses being run in rural areas.

Dr Ghodeswar also elaborated on various schemes run by Ministry of MSME to encourage, support, finance and guide the entrepreneurship. He however cautioned that businesses should not be run merely for gaining loans and subsidies. In fact, the concept of business, location, infrastructure, skilled and affordable manpower availability, networking, market place and finance are the factors which should be worked out before entering into the business. He explained that the successful business has 80% inspiration and 20% perspiration. To be a successful entrepreneur, one should have qualities of passion, strong work ethics, man management skills, creativity, competitiveness, self discipline, confidence etc.

Dr Deepa Panhekar, Head, Dept. of Chemistry, coordinated the program and also gave overview of the programme. Ms Priyanka Jain conducted the programme. Dr Prakash Bhongade, Head, BCA Dept. proposed vote of thanks. Prof. Subhash Somkuwar, Head, Botany Dept., presented memento to Dr Ghodeswar. 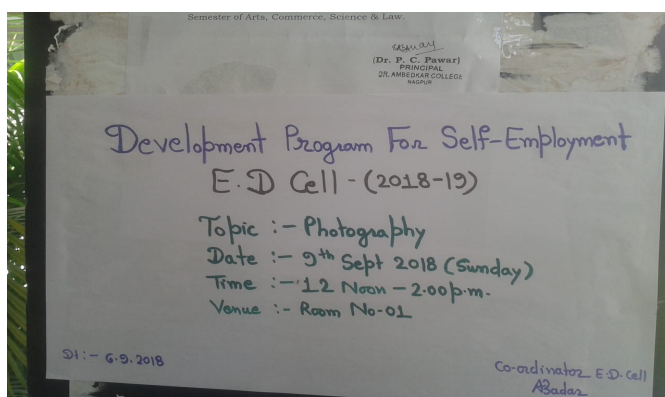

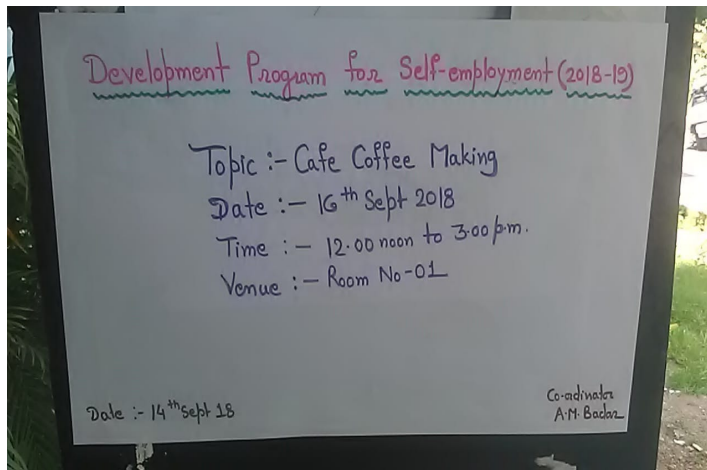

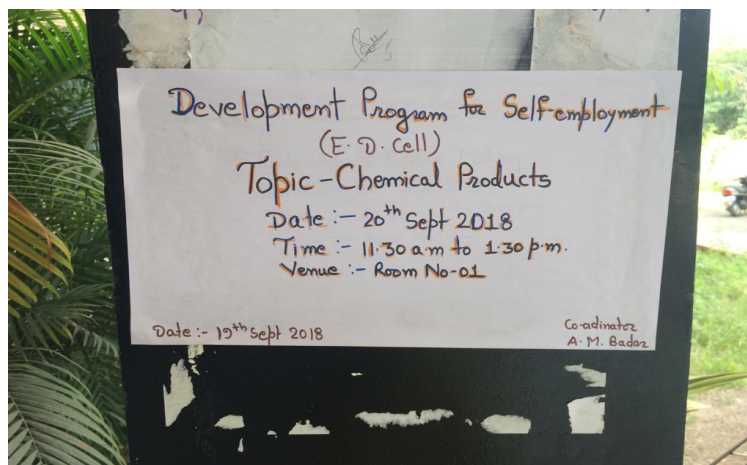
**2) Café Coffee Making Session: Date 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2018.**

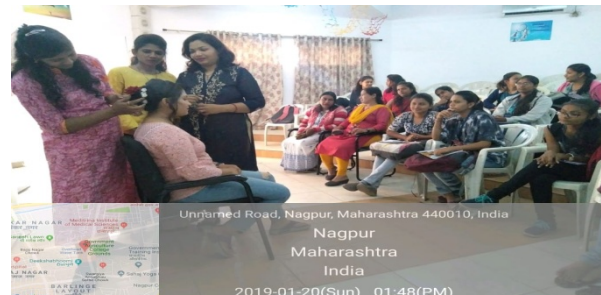
## 8) Face Makeup & Hairstyles Session: Date 20<sup>th</sup> January,, 2019.

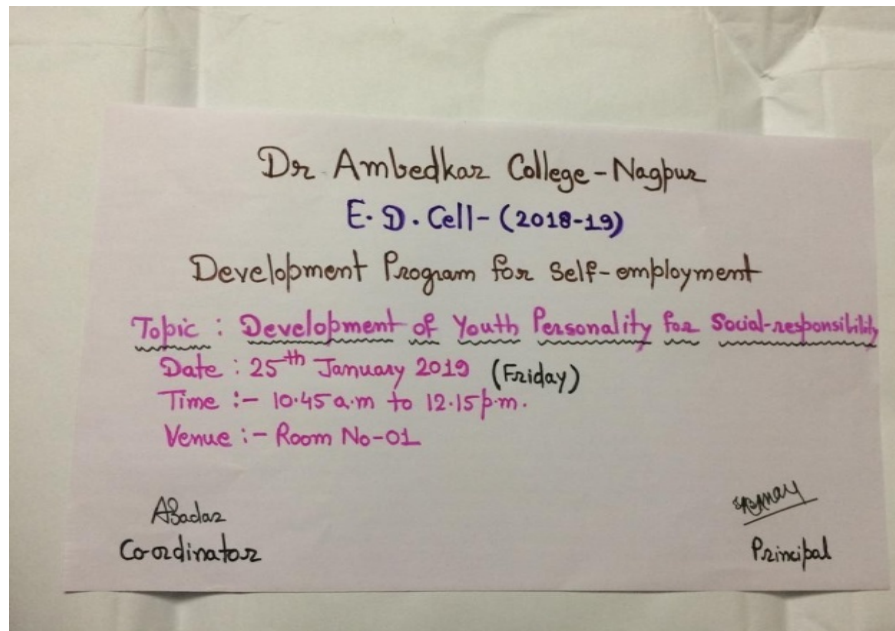


## 9) Development of Youth Personality for Social Responsibility:

The students were highly motivated by the speech given by Dr. Tekade. The programme was largely attended and ended with vote of thanks by Ms. Janhavi Burbure.

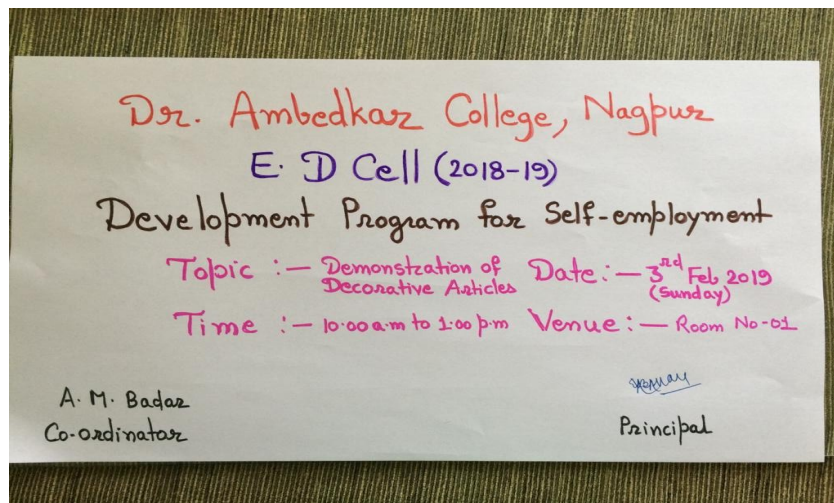


## 10) Demonstration of Making of Decorative Articles:

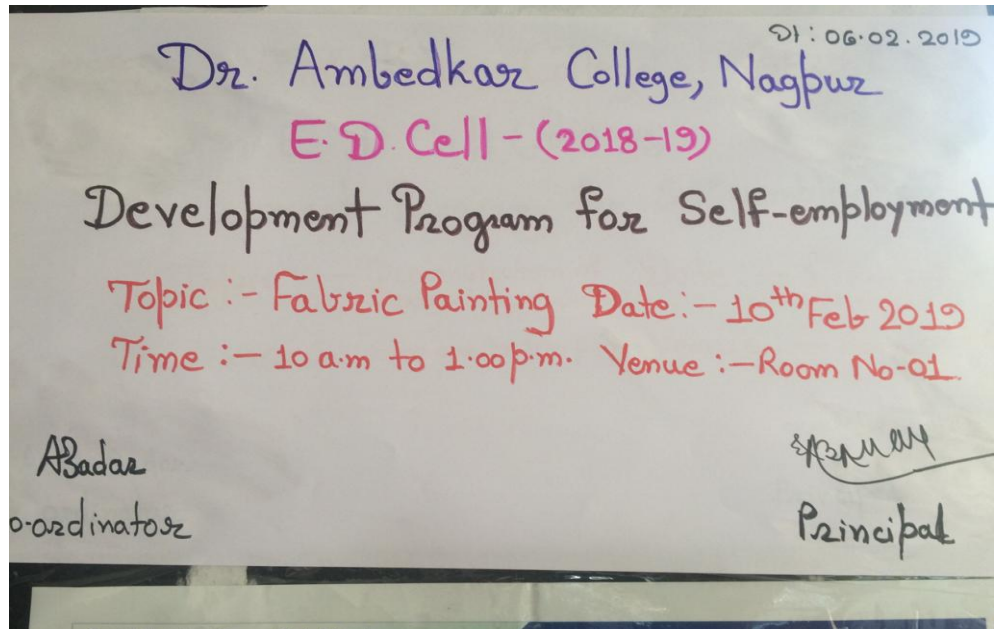


## 11) Demonstration of Fabric Painting:

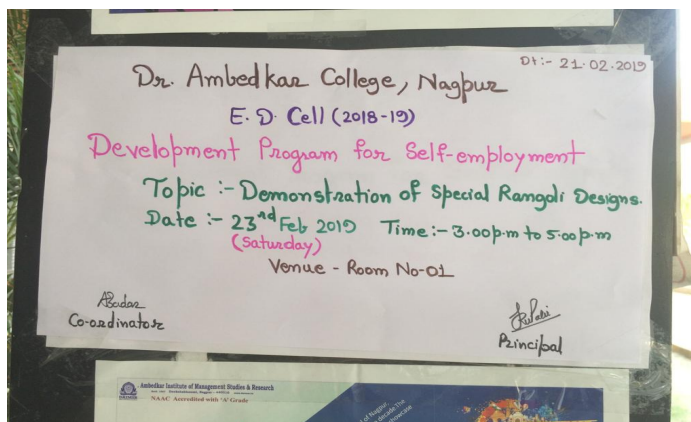


## 12) Demonstration of Sanskar Bharti Rangoli:

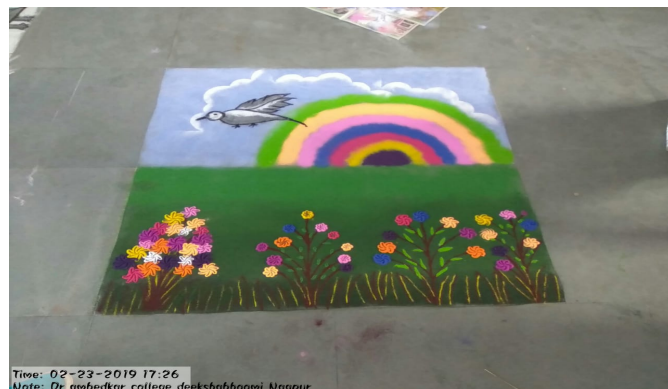

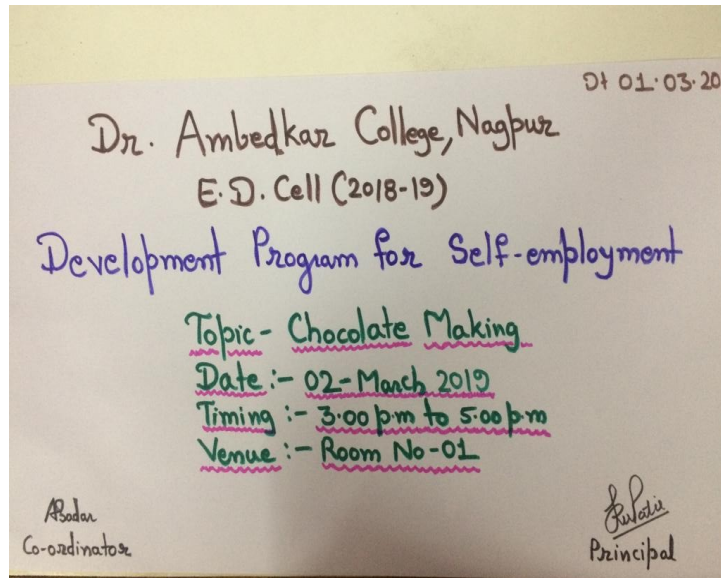


### 13) Demonstration of Chocolate Making:

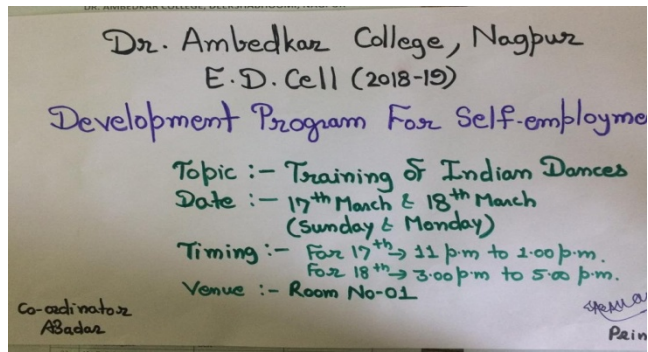


## 14) Training of Indian Cultural Dances – Bhangra and Garbha:

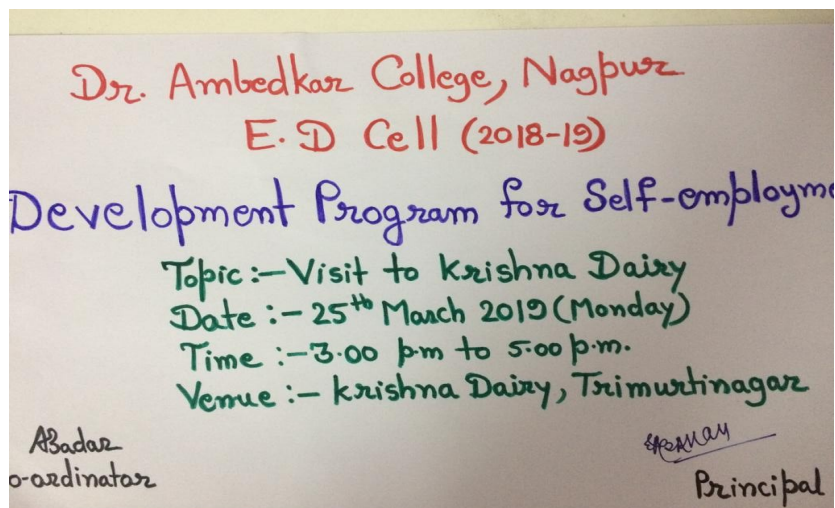

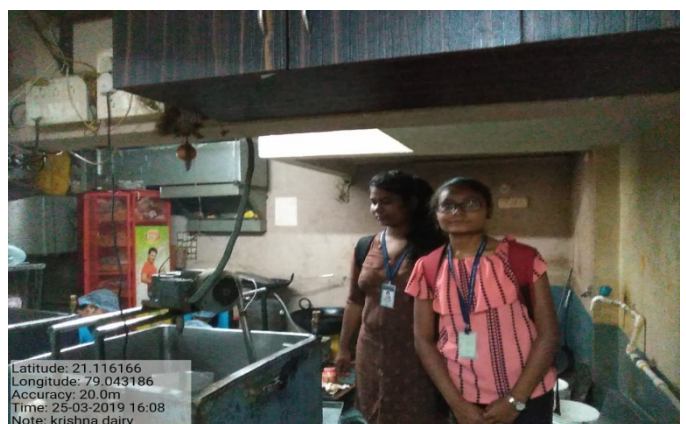
**15) Industrial Visit to Krishna Dairy, Trimurtinagar, Nagpur:**

In the training programme, Project Officers of M.C.E.D. inform the students about numerous opportunities available in various fields for enterprising individuals.
