
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


NOTICE

DETAILED REPORT:

Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur organised its 3rd HR Lecture series on the topic 'Outcome based Education – the Future of Education' for the faculty members on 13th January, 2023. Dr. B.A. Mehere, Principal, Dr. Mrs. Deepa Panhekar, IQAC co-ordinator presided over the function. Dr. Arti Wazalwar warmly welcomed the dignitaries, participants and delivered the introductory remarks.

Dr. Abhijeet Agashe, Controller of Examination, Ramdeobaba College of Engineering and Management was the Resource Person.

Dr. Agashe, started his deliberation, touching the origination of the concept "Outcome Based Education" right from Washington Accord to India signing the elite agreement and becoming a member. He emphasized the need for paradigm change in the present academic system in such a manner that it improves knowledge along with skill assuring employability to young graduates of any discipline.

He also focused the six parameters of Outcome Based Eductaion as projected in Blooms Taxonomy and highlighted the new regulations and guidelines of NAAC by stressing upon that any Institution desirous of getting better grading in the next cycle should implement Outcome Based Education curriculum effectively. He also pictured some models in various disciplines with an analysis of the need for global identity for the success and sustenance of the institution and requested the faculty to plan their teaching practices accordingly.

Dr. Agashe further delineated the expectations, the set roles and responsibilities of the faculty members in terms of academics and evaluation. He urged the faculties to be more self-conscious about quality education and research, and to be continuously involved in the improvement by self-competition, teamwork and also proliferated the role of teachers in motivating the students to be the industry ready as well as to pursue further as well as further studies.

Dr. Varsha Deshpande drew the curtains on the session with a vote of thanks. This session has created a great awareness among the faculties on Outcome Based Education and the need for restructuring the curriculum.


