ACTIVITY SESSION

If I ruled the world:


This activity was given to the students as an ice breaker activity so that they think about logical points and understand the role that lawyers play in the world. They were asked to imagine that they are given power to rule the world, what is that one change, which they would bring into the world and why. This helped the students evaluate and prioritise what does the world need today and why. They had to explain it with the help of strong and logical reasoning using examples and case laws if any. In this activity, they were also taught how to start and end their speeches in a structured format.

Where do you stand activity:

The activity required students to choose a team, proposition or opposition, after a topic being allotted, and try to convince the other team (opponents) and the audience, why their team shall win. The students were extremely charged up and tried their best to prove their stance and had so much to express. Through this activity they were taught not to just raise their points randomly, but to structure their points carefully, by giving reasons as to why their points are correct and giving examples to prove such points. Also, they were taught the role of body language while giving speeches.
