Rules of Debating :

1. Each speaker will get 5 minutes to deliver his/her speech.
2. The motion/topic for the debate has been given to the speakers in advance so you need to prove your stance with valid reasoning, logic, examples, and impact regarding the topic.
3. You need to prepare speeches for both, proposition as well as opposition side as you will be asked to speak either for or against the topic. It is advised, therefore, to think from both the sides of the topic.
4. Marks may be awarded as per the following criteria.

Sr.No.	Marking criteria	Marks
1	Content	10 marks
2	Style/ way of presenting your speech, confidence, eye contact, hand gestures, etc	10 marks
3	Strategy: the arguments put forward to oppose the points given by the other side	10 marks
4	Validity and logic: logical reasoning and examples that prove your points	10 marks

The decision of the Judge shall be final & binding on all the participants.

The topic of motion for LL.B (3 years) was ‘Capital Punishment – A bane or boon’ and LL.B (5 years) was ‘Economic Growth is more important than environmental protection’. The competition was conducted by Ms. Sanika Duragkar, Executive Committee Member of The Nouveau Corporates.

The aim of organizing debate competition was to hone the public speaking skills of the students and teach them to be articulate while expressing their thoughts and opinions.
