Report:

Dr. Ambedkar College, Department of Law, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur, through the Centre for Constitutional Law and Public Policy Debate organized a Guest Lecture on the topic “**Social Sensitization**” on 14th September, 2022. The Speaker of the program was Dr. D.R. Peshwe, Professor, Metallurgical and Materials Engineering and Dean (Faculty Welfare), Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology (VNIT), Nagpur. The aim of the Guest lecture was to imbibe a basic sense of social responsibility in the students and also to sensitize them about the social causes and issues enabling them to take part in philanthropic activities. The program commenced with a Welcome address by Dr. H.V. Menon, Professor & Head, Department of Law, Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur. The Introductory remarks were given by Dr. VarshaDeshpande, Professor and Co-ordinator, Centre for Constitutional Law and Public Policy Debate in which she highlighted various activities carried on by the Centre along with the importance of “Social Internship” along with “ Legal Internship” in the lives of law students.

In this program, the Guest Speaker discussed about the different NGOs working for different social causes. He gave insight about “Snehankur” which provides medical help in excellent hospitals for unwed mothers who relinquish their children. These women are then provided counselling and when required an opportunity to take professional employment or education free of cost. He also talked about “Snehalaya” which works towards developing the awareness and capability of individuals who have been deprived of their fundamental rights as a result of the inequalities that exist in our society and also towards offering a safe exit point to women and their children trapped in the crippling cycle of poverty and abuse. He also shed some light on the Charitable Trust, named “Mahan”, a 'Non-Profit' & 'Non-Government' organization providing preventive & curative medical facilities to tribal people in Melghat. He also gave valuable insight about another NGO named “Goonj” which envisions to grow as an idea across regions, economies and countries using urban discard as a tool to alleviate poverty and enhance the dignity of the underprivileged people of the world.

Dr. Peshwe also discussed about “Prayaas”, a social club of VNIT with a motto of “One can’t help many but everyone can help someone”. The members of this Club invest time, efforts and creativity for a better society. He also discussed in detail about the Anandvan project which

was started by 'Baba Amte' who worked for the rehabilitation and empowerment of people suffering from leprosy.

The program was conducted by Dr. Varsha Deshpande, Professor and Co-ordinator, Centre for Constitutional Law and Public Policy Debate. Ms. Anusha Patre, Assistant Professor, Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur proposed the Vote of Thanks

The lecture was then followed by Question – Answer Session.


The Guest lecture was attended by 75 participants approximately comprising of the students from LL.B and LL.M. of the Department of Law and the Faculty members of the Department of Law. The feedback was also taken from the students.
