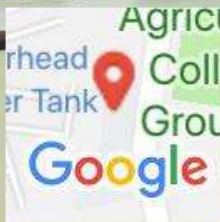

Women Development Cell of Dr.Ambedkar College celebrated International Women's Day on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2019. On this Occasion 'a guest lecture on **Cancer Awareness**' was organized. The guest speaker was Dr.Jaiprakash Baraskar an eminent Oncosurgeon of Nagpur.

Sir has enlightened the girl students about Breast & Cervical Cancer awareness.

The Programme started with lightening of lamp and garlanding the portraits of Lord Gautam Buddha and Param Pujya Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar.Dr.Baraskar quoted women is the backbone of the society, if women are healthy the whole family is healthy. He has quoted an example of Defence Minister Mrs. Nirmala Sitharaman –Cancer survivor. Every year huge number of Breast cancer is detected and early detection can save the life.

Sir also threw light on various preventive measures which can help to reduce the risk of breast cancer. He also made aware that how genetic background, smoking and consumption of alcohol and environmental changes and chemical exposure lead to cancer.

Sir also has awared that women with family history of Breast cancer, mutated chromosomes, early menstruation and late menopause are at high risk of Breast cancers.

He had also explained how early diagnosis can lead to effective treatment like FNAC,Biopsy,Mammography,PGT scan. There are many treatment methods available such as Chemotherapy Radiotherapy and Hormone therapy.

He concluded his speech by stressing the need of regular exercising and with a positive note “**KEEP CALM & FIGHT ON WITH A POSITIVE APPROACH.** We can conquer cancer.

Lecture was followed by interactive session with the students and the faculty students.
