

REPORT ON DEBATE COMPETITION ON "IMPLEMENTATION OF UCC CAN ACHIEVE NATIONAL INTEGRATION" ORGANIZED FOR II SEM 5 YRS AND IV SEM 5 YRS

Department of Law, Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur had organized debate competition on "IMPLEMENTATION OF UCC CAN ACHIEVE NATIONAL INTEGRATION", on 9th March 2024 to mark the celebration of International Women's Day 2024. This debate competition was designed by our Alumni Mrs. Rucha Dhakras Pathak to create awareness among the budding lawyers about new emerging trends in Personal Laws. It was organized for the Students of BALLB (5 years course), IV sem and II sem. Total 14 students registered for the debate. Out of which 10 students participated in the debate that was conducted in-house. The debate consisted of a motion to be spoken for and against. Students were given a chance of rebuttal as well. The rules of the debate were as follows.

DEBATE COMPETETION 09TH MARCH 2024

Rules for Debate Competition:

- 1. The topic of the debate is "Implementation of UCC can achieve National Integration".
- Each individual will choose a side. One will speak "for the motion" and the other will speak "against the motion".
- 2. Each individual will get 5 minutes, 4 minutes (4+1 minutes) to speak and 1 minute for interjection.
- 3. An indicator will be given after 4 minutes. Exceeding 5 minutes will lead to deduction of points so kindly adhere to the time limit.
- 4. Paper reading while debating can affect the results of the participants.
- 5. Offensive, personal or defamatory expressions will not be accepted in any case.

The debate competition was co-ordinated by Dr. Mrs. Vaishali A Sukhdeve and Mrs. Rucha Dhakras Pathak and all the important instructions regarding debate were given to the students accordingly. The time window of 5 minutes each was given in which students had to put forth their point of view. The judges for the competition were Dr. Ms. Pratima Lokhande and Ms. Khushi Bajaj.

At the end of the competition, the esteemed judges interacted with the participants. Dr. Ms. Pratima Lokhande spoke about the need for the participants to do in depth research about the topic of the debate and explained to them how to develop their legal acumen. She also spoke about the importance of understanding Uniform Civil Code – its advantages and its disadvantages strictly from a legal point of view and what is the need of bringing in a common personal law. She motivated the participants on their efforts and congratulated them for their performance. Similarly. Ms. Khushi Bajaj interacted with the participants on the debating styles. She explained the participants what was the importance of proper body language, their content, and the styles of rebuttal. She emphasized on the need of focusing on the formal debating styles by the law students. Ms. Bajaj also congratulated the participants on their performance.

On the same day results were declared. The winners were given gift sets comprising of books. The First prize was won by Mr. Parth Nakade (BA.LLB. IV sem 5 yrs course). The First runner up was Miss Kanak Bhandakkar (BA.LLB. IV sem, 5 years course). The Second Runner up was Mr. Krishnan Meshram (BA.LL.B IV Sem, 5 years course).
