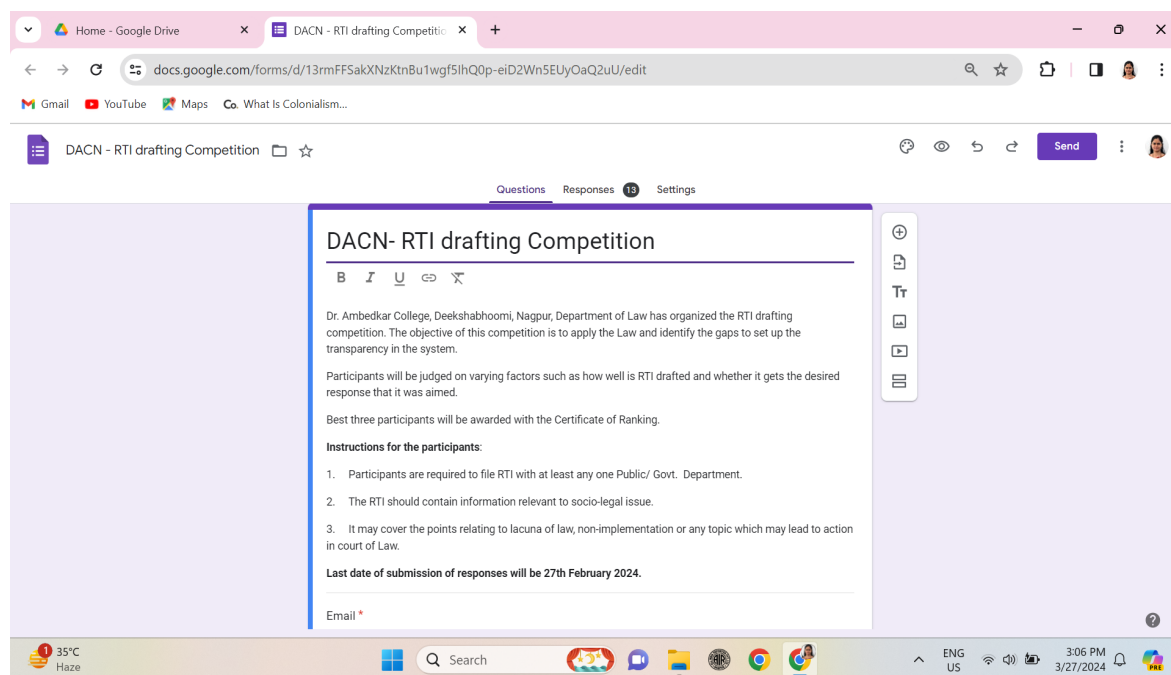

You are requested to furnish the following information or documents.

- The recent statistics by The Indian Express, 154 farmers dies by suicide daily, What are the efficacy or precautions to secure their lives and save future of their families.
- What is the reason that the loan on the tractor is minimum 9 percent and on other luxurious cars ending at 9 percent then how can the Primary industry like agriculture prosper? Can the change of interest rates on tractor that are used by the farmers to produce crops be altered?
- There are various loopholes on to the schemes of the government like half (7.62 crores) the target of Agriculture Department i.e 12.5 crores farmers have registered for the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi also the Schemes are lagging the explanation to the beneficiaries. What is the stand by the Official to declare the effective solution for the same. The maximum farmers are illiterate and cannot access to the policies and the internet schemes.
- Even after providing Health Insurance and exemption to the crops, the rate of farmers are disheartened largely and asking for the justice so please provide adequate justifications for the same.
- The Farmers protest are resumed now again asking for the increase of the MSP i.e. the set price which the government purchases their crops. The huge torture and agony is faced by them as they contribute their time and sweat for the same and do not get the necessary cost for the same.
