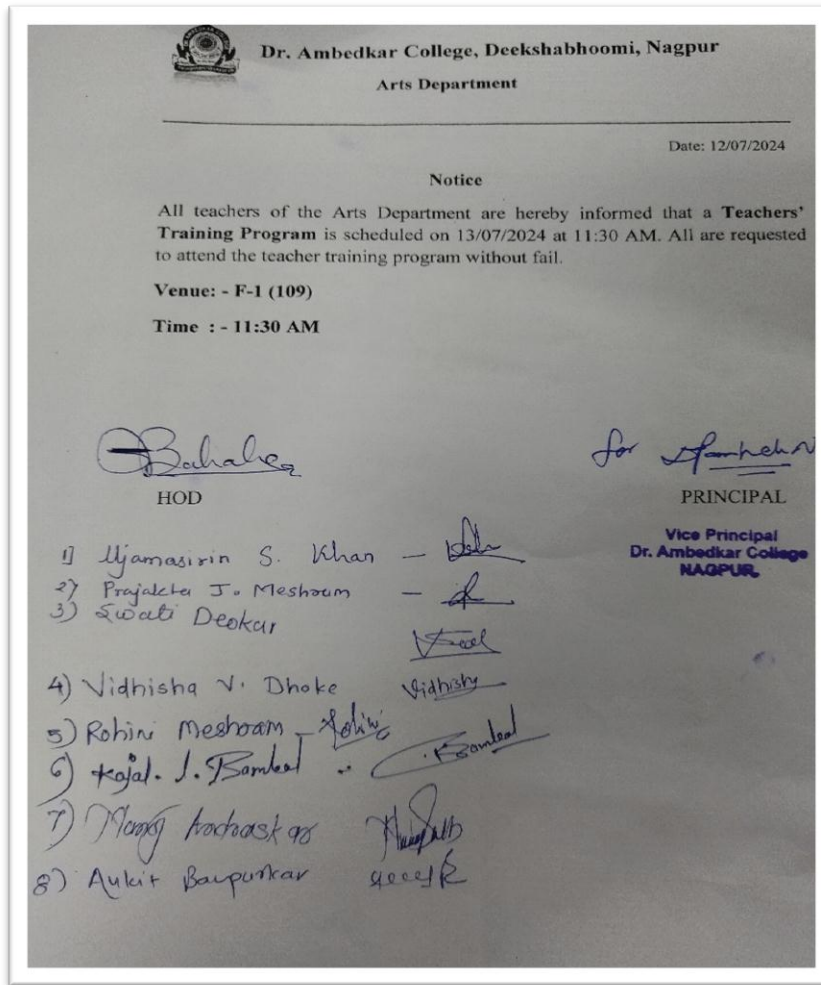
**TITLE OF THE PROGRAMME: TEACHERS' TRAINING PROGRAM**

In-order to equip teachers with modern teaching aids and to make them technologically self-reliant, a Teachers' Training Program designed for the teachers of the arts department at Dr. Ambedkar College, Deekshabhoomi, Nagpur was held on 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2024. Mr. Manoj Andraskar and Mr. Ankit Banpurkar (Assistant Professors) from the department of English conducted

the sessions specifically focussed on developing the skills of teacher's in utilizing the modern technologies for academic purposes.

The objectives of the training sessions were to familiarize teachers with Google tools, to demonstrate the effective use of Google Classroom as teaching aid and to introduce Canva- A Graphic Design App for the creation of academic content

The training at 11: 30 AM started with a brief introduction of the instructors by Assistant Professor, Ms. Rohini Meshram. In consideration of the keen interest shown by the teachers regarding the training. Ms. Rohini highlighted the importance of such training programs for the better understanding of teaching aids and applications. Mr. Manoj Andraskar began the first session with the demonstration of various Google applications such as drives, Google Classroom and E-mail. He explained the functionalities of Google classroom and provided a step by step guide to set up a virtual classroom, assign tasks and grade students' work. The session also had a hands-on practice, allowing teachers to create their own Google Classrooms and experiment with the various available tools.

Following this, Mr. Ankit Banpurkar commenced the second session on Canva- a graphic design platform. Mr. Banpurkar highlighted the importance of designing and visual aids in enhancing learning experiences, and showed how Canva could be used to create engaging presentations and other educational materials. He demonstrated how flyers, posters, certificate could be designed for the educational purposes. In the end, in his concluding remarks, Mr. Banpurkar linked graphic design to creative art.

A total of 16 teachers from the department of humanities attended the training. The training program was interactive in nature and thus, teachers posed their doubts and queries and the trainers promptly provided the trainees with solutions.

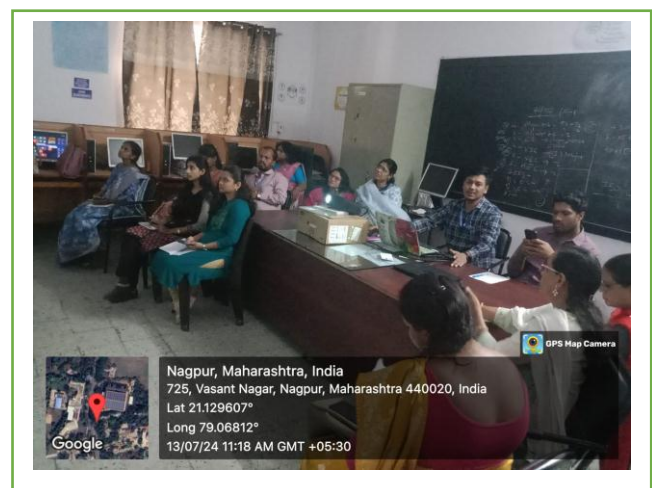
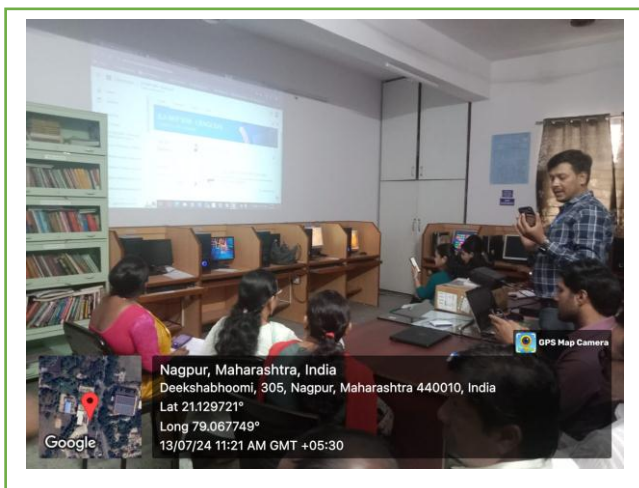
The training was concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Anita Tirpude, Assistant Professor, who expressed gratitude to the trainers and to Prof. Dr.

Shailesh Bhahadure for his guidance in organising the training program. The trainees at the end left with a sense of satisfaction on learning new skills.

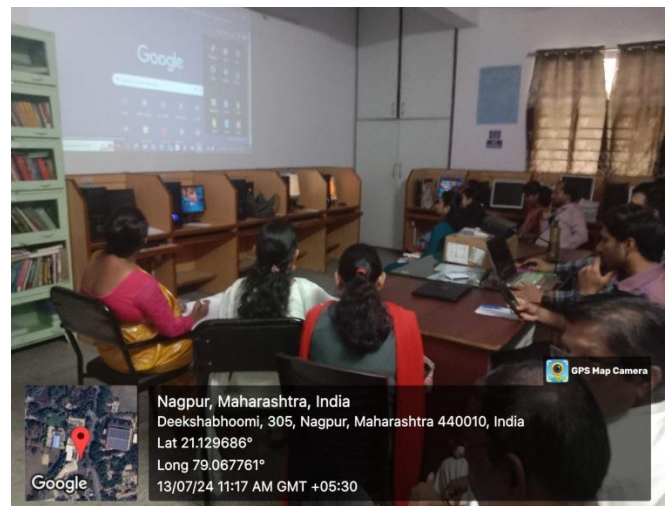
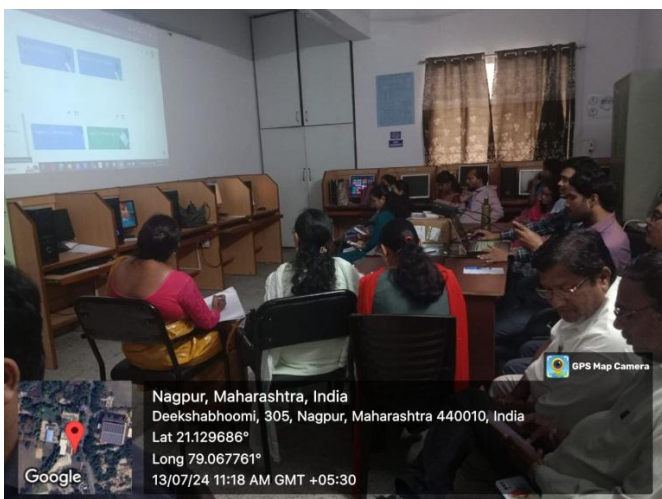
