The Human Resource Development Cell of the College organized its first HR activity of the academic session 2023-24 on Friday, the 12th January 2024. This session was planned with the key office bearers of the Bank of Maharashtra, Nagpur and was organized for the members of the teaching and non-teaching staff members of the college. The aim behind holding this interactive activity was to educate and spread awareness amongst the attendees about different and diverse ways in which wise investments can be made. The staff from Bank of Maharashtra was deliberately invited since the staff members of the college have their salary accounts in the said bank.

The team of office bearers from the Bank of Maharashtra addressed the members of the teaching and non-teaching staff about the vigilance they need to have about wise money saving and investments which can reap them good financial benefits and help in wealth creation, while also taking care of tax saving. Mr Shubhankar Ganguly spoke about the loans on immovable property which the Bank offers and explained the entire scheme in great detail.
