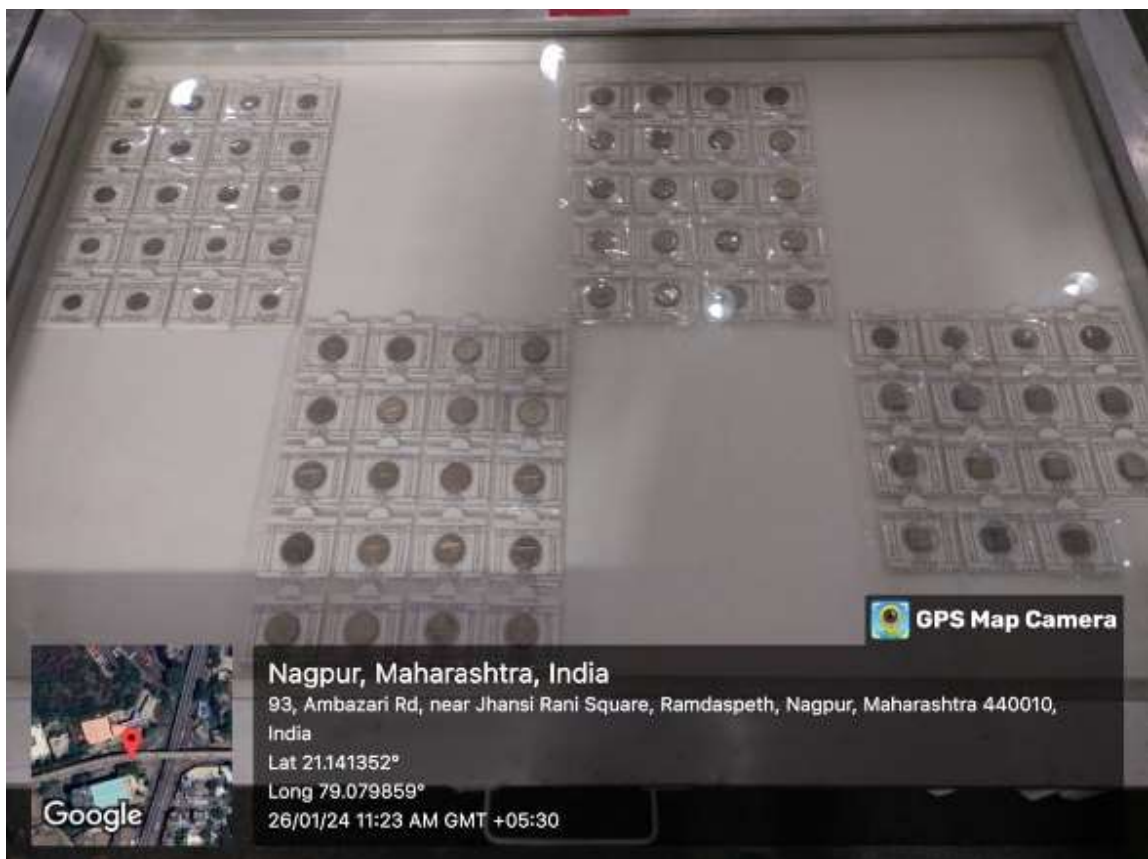
“Visit to Coin Exhibition – NAGMONEY 2024”

A group of students from Dr. Ambedkar College, Nagpur, accompanied by Dr. A. R. Bansod, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics, Dr. Ambedkar College, Nagpur visited the Nagmoney 2024 held on 26th January 2024. The exhibition provided a unique opportunity for students to explore the fascinating world of coins and currency, gaining insights into history, economics, and culture.

The exhibition spanned a vast timeframe, showcasing coins from the ancient era of Mauryan, Gupta, and Mughal empires to all the way to modern commemorative pieces.
