The Department of English conducted a 30-hour comprehensive Spoken English Course which aimed at enhancing the communication skills of students. The course with a specific focus was curated and facilitated by Mr. Dilip Rathod and Mrs. Swati Deokar (Assistant Professor) to meet the communication related demands of the modern professional sectors. As it provided a productive platform for the college students to enhance their speaking skills, the department received the registration of 228 students from all the disciplines.

The course covered essential aspects of Spoken English including basics of grammar, vocabulary building, verb forms, word forms, common proverbs, reading, listening and presentation skills to assess participants' comprehension of the course modules.

The Course was inaugurated on 18 September 2024 by Dr. Shailesh Bahadure (Professor & Head, Department of English). In his address, he said that in a competitive job market, English

communication skills are often a prerequisite for many roles. Employers value candidates who can effectively communicate ideas, collaborate with teams, and interact with clients. Proficiency in English not only opens doors to better job prospects but also aids in career advancement. In the current scenario, as many sectors are looking for freshers with a good command over communication in at least one foreign language, the course is relevantly picked up and planned. Dr. Bahadure congratulated the course coordinators for the entire preparations required for the course and thanked for being proactive in the larger interest of the learners.

Different sessions were conducted for 30 clock hours as per the syllabus designed and sufficient space was provided for practical sessions where students participated with great enthusiasm. A few audio video sessions were organised on Listening and Reading skill during the course. These sessions stressed mainly upon different accents and the construction and deconstruction of the sentences followed by presentation skills helped students to learn important modalities which are generally followed during interviews and recruitment process.
